COMMENTS

The low temperatures coupled with high hygrometric differences experienced towards the end of January has given way to hot and dry conditions. Some plantation districts are experiencing overcast conditions. The unpredictable weather conditions may yet lead to a delayed “Dimbula Season”. We are yet to see a well-developed quality season from the Western Sector, due mainly to the unsettled weather. The rainfall recorded is not likely to have a significant impact on the crop intakes.

With quality from the Western sector still below what is expected at this time of the year, the buyers were mainly interested in the cleaner, brighter and coloury teas on offer. The 1.08 Mkgs of Ex-estate teas that came up for sale at today’s auctions met with irregularly lower demand with a number of invoices remaining unsold due to lack of bids. Whilst the Western BOPs sold at last levels a few bright Western BOPFs sold well on special inquiry. Nuwara Eliya BOPs gained and the BOPFs were firm. The noteworthy feature of today’s Ex-estate market was the strong demand for the handful of light bright leafy teas from Nuwara Eliya district with some character which sold at very attractive price levels. The Uva/Udapussellawa were firm to easier. Low Grown CTC PF1s declined whilst the High and Medium types too declined and remained unsold.

There was lower demand for the 3.2 Mkgs of Low Grown which were available at this week's tea auction. Better OP1s were firm, however the poorer varieties shed Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-. Select Best BOP1s advanced Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, the balance were firm. Better OPs maintained but the balance declined Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-. OPAs were lower by Rs.10/-. Pekoe/Pekoe1s declined Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. BOP/BOP.SPs eased Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-. FBOP/FBOPF1s declined Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Tippy varieties all shed on last week's levels.





Select best BOPs gained Rs.10/- to Rs.20/- selectively following air mail inquiry, whilst the below best and plainer sorts declined by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Select best BOPFs were selectively dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/- following air mail inquiry, whilst the below best and plainer sorts declined by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/- and more. Medium BOPs were irregular, whilst the BOPFs were easier by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-.

BOPs gained following quality, whilst the BOPFs were irregular.

BOPs were selectively dearer, whilst the BOPFs declined by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/- on average. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were selectively dearer, whilst the BOPFs were easier by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-.

Low Grown PF1s were barely steady with most invoices declining by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. High & Medium PF1s were easier by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Low Grown BP1s were irregularly dearer, whilst the High & Medium sorts were mostly easier by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-.

Fair demand. Select best OP1s were firm to irregularly dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/- and more following quality, whilst best OP1s too gained Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, below best and poorer sorts were firm to at times lower by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-. Select best BOP1s gained Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, whilst the balance maintained last levels. Select best OPs were fully firm, best and below best varieties eased Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, poorer sorts too were lower by a similar margin. Select best OPAs shed Rs.10/- on average, whilst best types were steady, below best types tended lower by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, however poorer sorts gained Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-. Select best Pekoes declined sharply by Rs.30/- to Rs.40/-, the balance too were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Shotty Pekoe1s declined Rs.30/- to Rs.50/-, best types were mainly firm, below best and poorer types were irregularly lower by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-. Lower demand for Tippy/Small leaf teas. Select best and best BOPs were irregularly lower by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, whilst below best and poorer sorts declined Rs.10/- to Rs.15/-. Select best BOPSPs declined Rs.5/- to Rs.10/- and more at times following quality, whilst below best and poorer sorts too declined by a similar margin. Select best and best FBOPs declined further Rs.10/- to Rs.20/- from last week's closing levels, whilst below best and poorer sorts too shed Rs.10/- to Rs.15/- and more at times. Select best FBOPF1s were firm to irregularly lower Rs.10/- to Rs.15/-, whilst best and below best types were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.15/-, poorer sorts were firm. Select best Tippy varieties declined further, whilst best and the below best varieties declined sharply.

Select best and best liquoring Fngs1s declined Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, whilst the below best and poorer sorts were easier by Rs.10/-. Select best BMs appreciated Rs.10/- to Rs.15/-, whilst the below best and poorer sorts appreciated Rs.10/- to Rs.15/-. All BPs dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Select best BOP1As were firm on last, best BOP1As were firm to dearer by Rs.10/- and more at times following quality, whilst below best and poorer sorts appreciated by Rs.10/-Rs.15/- and more.

Select best Dust1s were firm to lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, whilst other Dusts types and cleaner secondaries continued in same trend as last. High & Medium Grown CTCs were lower by Rs.15/- to Rs.20/-

due to lower demand attracted by exporters, however Low Grown CTCs continued to remain firm. Low Grown Dust/Dust1s increased Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, whilst others remained firm to last.

Good and improved widespread demand for the 153,397 packages (9,915,132 kilos) on offer at irregular prices closely following quality and only 9.54% remained unsold.

The few best BP1s in the market were heavily discounted while brighter categories were firm to USC18 dearer with medium descriptions USC4 to USC26 above last rates. Lower mediums were irregular ranging between USC4 to USC18 dearer to easier by upto USC6 while plainer types varied between USC2 to USC12 above last prices to easier by upto USC34 and more.

Best PF1s on offer gained upto USC12 with brighter sorts USC4 to USC20 dearer while mediums saw an irregular enquiry varying between USC6 to USC14 dearer to easier by a similar level. Lower medium PF1s were irregular and ranged between USC4 to USC6 dearer to easier by upto USC12 with plainer descriptions varying between firm to USC10 dearer to easier by a similar rate.

Best PDUSTs in the market lost upto USC22 with brighter sorts steady to USC14 dearer but some invoices were discounted by the same rate while mediums met an irregular interest ranging between firm to USC20 dearer to easier by upto USC10. Lower mediums were fully firm to USC8 easier with plainer sorts varying between steady to USC4 dearer to easier by upto USC8.

The few best DUST1s available appreciated by USC6 while brighter types were fully firm to a few cents dearer with mediums steady. Lower mediums were barely firm to USC6 easier while plainer types ranged between firm to USC4 dearer to easier by upto USC8.

In the secondary catalogues BPs and PFs gained. Clean well sorted coloury FNGS were dearer while similar DUSTs appreciated. Other FNGS were dearer and DUSTs were steady. BMFs were well absorbed.

Yemen, other Middle Eastern countries, Afghanistan, Sudan, Kazakhstan and other CIS states showed strong support with more interest from Russia, Bazaar and Iran. Pakistan Packers maintained activity. Egyptian Packers were active but at lower rates while UK showed interest but was selective. Somalia maintained activity at the lower end of the market.

CTC LEAF: 35,606 packages of teas on offer met with a strong demand at irregular rates.

BROKENS: A few good liquoring Brokens on offer met with a strong demand and were dearer by Tk.5/- to Tk.7/- . These could be quoted between Tk.205/- and Tk.220/- . Mediums met with a fairly good demand and sold in line with quality. Plain teas once again were selective and there were fair withdrawals in this category, End of season teas met with more interest but again a fair weight was withdrawn.

FANNINGS: Good liquoring Fannings again met with a strong demand and were mostly dearer often by Tk.4/- to Tk.6/- and these could be quoted between Tk. 205/- and Tk.210/- . Mediums met with a good market and were generally a little easier. Plain teas were in less demand and there were several withdrawals. End of season types saw a little more interest but a fair weight of these were withdrawn without bids.

CTC DUST: 4,814 packages of teas on offer met with a good demand. Good liquoring varieties sold at around last levels. Plainer teas met with a selective demand and tended easier. However, end of season teas were generally neglected with heavy withdrawals. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: Offerings continued to be quite large comprising of a heavy weight of end of season teas. Buyers were strongly competing for all good liquoring types which advanced in price whilst Medium types were about steady. Plain and end of season teas met with a discriminating market and sold in line with quality. Blenders operated actively with more interest from the Loose tea buyers.

Good liquoring Dusts were once again a strong feature of the sale.

CTC Leaf: There was fair demand. Assams across all categories sold at irregular levels in line with quality. Select weight of earlier invoices of liquoring Assams sold at steady levels. There was good demand for the nominal weight of Good Dooars on offer which sold at firm levels. Medium, plainer and BLF Dooars continued to sell around last levels.

CTC Dust: There was good demand with Assams selling at irregular levels following quality. The nominal weight of Dooars was around last levels.

M/s Hindustan Unilever operated on the range of medium Assam broken, clean, good liquoring secondary grades and fannings in the leaf market. They were active on better liquoring as well as medium Assams in the dust market and also provided good support on plainer and BLF Dooars. The Western India buyers operated on the range of liquoring teas on offer. There was some enquiry from the Exporters on larger broken, fannings and clean secondary grades. Regional packeteers / other blenders operated on liquoring Assams with useful support on plainer and BLF Dooars. The local traders continued to remain active on the Dooars.
