The Auction averages for the month of December 2023 recorded at Rs.1,186.41, is a decline of Rs.267.83 in comparison to December 2022 which was at Rs.1,454.24. When analyzing the respective elevations, the High Growns recorded an average of Rs.1,071.97 which is a negative variance of Rs.287.81 in comparison to Rs.1,359.78 in December last year. The Medium Growns too recorded a negative variance of Rs.218.83 with an average of Rs.1,019.03 when compared to Rs.1,237.86 in December 2022. Similarly, the Low Growns recorded a negative variance of Rs.256.19 with an average of Rs.1,278.08 in comparison to Rs.1,534.27 in December last year.

The 0.73Mkg of Ex-Estate teas on offer met with good demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs were firm to irregularly lower, the below best and plainer varieties declined. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs were irregularly easier, the below best and plainer varieties too barely maintained last levels and were mostly easier. Nuwara Eliya BOPs / BOPFs met with improved demand. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were firm to dearer at times, the BOPF followed a similar trend. UVA BOPs were barely steady, the BOPFs maintained. Low Grown CTC BP1s gained selectively, the High and Medium sorts were irregularly dearer. Low Grown CTC PF1s were tending easier, the High and Medium sorts were irregularly dearer.

The 2.1Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with fair demand. In the Leafy segment, OPA's were firm, OPs too met with fair demand. OP1s and BOP1s were firm to dearer. PEKOEs met with good demand, PEKOE1s were irregularly lower. In the Small Leaf segment, FBOPs were dearer. FF1s met with good demand. FF varieties were marginally easier. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOP grades met with fair demand. In the Premium Flowery segment, smaller tippy varieties were lower, whilst the others met with good demand.

Turkey, Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.

Western Teas

Select best Western BOPs barely maintained last levels and tended irregularly lower, the below best and plainer sorts too declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- on average. Select best Western BOPFs were irregularly lower, the below best and plainer sorts were mostly tending easier. Medium BOPs were firm to a little dearer at times, the BOPFs too were firm on last levels.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

The limited quantity of BOP/ BOPFs sold well and gained from last levels.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs barely maintained, the BOPFs were mostly firm. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were firm to a little dearer at times, the BOPFs too followed a similar trend.

CTC Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s gained following special inquiry, the High and Medium sorts were irregularly dearer. Low Grown PF1s were easier, the High and Medium sorts were firm to a little dearer at times.

Low Grown

Select best OP1s tended lower, others attracted good demand. Well-made OPs along with the secondaries gained following quality. Select best OPAs were firm to dearer, others gained irregularly. Select best BOP1s were mostly dearer, best types eased from last levels, secondaries were firm to dearer. Well-made Pekoes along with the heavy bold Pekoe invoices maintained firm, others showed a marginal increase. Select best Pekoe1s were firm to easier, rest met with fair demand.

Select best and best BOPs were firm, below best and secondary types were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with fair demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best and best FBOPF1s were firm to dearer by Rs.30/- to Rs.40/-, below best types were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, secondary types were firm. Select best FBOP types were firm, best FBOPs were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/- and more following quality, below best types were dearer by Rs.60/- to Rs.80/-, secondary types were firm. FBOPF varieties were lower by a few rupees. All the Premium Flowery teas met with reasonable demand.

Select best and best BPs maintained on last levels, whilst below best and poorer varieties were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Select best BOP1As were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.60/-, best types were firm to dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.80/-, below best types declined by Rs.30/- to Rs.50/-, whilst poorer sorts were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-.

SETTLEMENT OF QUALITY CLAIMS - PROCEDURAL STEPS

We refer to CTTA Circular No 05 of 2023 dated February 10, 2023, on the settlement of quality claims.

The procedural steps outlined below aim to clarify any uncertainties in the process.

Reference By-Law 36(a),

All objections/complaints, relating to quality, description, or packaging of teas, shall be communicated in writing by the Buyer and/or Co-Buyer to the Seller or Selling Broker so as to be received by the Seller or the Selling Broker, as the case may be, within fifty-one calendar days from the date of auction or sale of the tea concerned.

Reference By-Law 36(c),

Immediately on receipt of the objection/complaint, the Seller, or the Buyer and/or Co-Buyer may seek the intervention of the Selling Broker to facilitate a settlement of the difference or dispute. In the event such a prompt settlement cannot be reached:

- I. The Selling Broker shall advise the Seller, in writing, within 2 working days of receiving the report of the objection/complaint.
- II. The Seller shall confirm acceptance, or otherwise, of the claim, in writing, within 7 calendar days of receiving the advice of the Selling Broker of the objection / complaint.

SETTLEMENT OF QUALITY CLAIMS - PROCEDURAL STEPS

Once a claim is made, reference By-Law 36(c),

III. The Buyer and/or Co-Buyer shall submit to the Selling Broker a formal claim, on confirmation of its validity by the Seller, within 7 calendar days, thereafter.

IV. The formal claim made by the Buyer and/or Co-Buyer may be settled by the Seller or the Seller's Broker in any one of the following ways, within 14 calendar days of the receipt of such claim:

As per III and IV above, a period of 21 calendar days [7+14] is available to make a formal claim to a seller settlement.

From the 22nd day onwards, interest will be charged up to the Seller's settlement. The interest rate will be based on the Central Bank of Sri Lanka (CBSL) published rate (%) for the week plus 1%.
