COMMENTS



The Auction averages for the month of December 2024 recorded at Rs.1,184.82 is a marginal decline in comparison to December 2023 which was at Rs.1,186.41. When analyzing the respective elevations, the High Growns recorded an average of Rs.1,128.16 with a positive variance of Rs.56.19 in comparison to Rs.1,071.97 in December 2023, the Medium Growns too recorded a positive variance of Rs.18.74 with an average of Rs.1,037.77 when compared to Rs.1,019.03 in 2023. However, the Low Growns recorded a negative variance of Rs.24.32 with an average of Rs.1,253.76 in December 2024 in comparison to Rs.1,278.08 in December 2023.

0.79Mkg of Ex- Estate teas on offer met with irregular demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs gained selectively following special inquiry, the below best types were irregularly dearer, the plainer varieties however, were easier. A few Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs gained following special inquiry, the others were firm on last levels. The below best and plainer varieties were tending irregular. Nuwara Eliya BOPs were firm to dearer, the BOPFs mostly remained unsold. Uda Pussellawa BOPs barely maintained last levels, a few select best invoices of BOPFs gained sharply, however the others were firm. Uva BOPs declined, the BOPFs were firm on last levels. Low Grown CTC BP1s declined from last week's levels, the High and Medium BP1s were irregularly dearer. Low Grown CTC PF1s were firm, the High and Medium sorts were firm to dearer.

The 2.5Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with fair demand. In the Leafy segment, Well-made OPs/OPAs were firm to dearer, others met with good demand. OP1s in general were firm to dearer. BOP1s were firm to dearer. PEKOEs/ PEOKOE1s met with mixed interest. In the Small Leaf segment, FBOPs were firm to dearer. FF1s gained irregularly. The BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOPSP and BOPs met with fair demand. FF varieties were lower to last. Premium flowery teas met with good demand.

Turkey, Russia and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.





MARKET DESCRIPTION

Western Teas

A few select best Western High Grown BOPs gained Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-following special inquiry, the below best and plainer varieties were firm to a little easier with some invoices remaining unsold. A few invoices of select best Western High Grown BOPFs gained Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- at times, others were firm, the below best and plainer varieties were tending irregular and mostly maintained last levels. Medium BOP / BOPFs were firm on last levels.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOPs were firm to a little dearer following quality, the BOPFs mostly remained unsold.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs mostly declined, the BOPFs were firm on last levels. Uda Pussellawa BOPs barely maintained last levels, a few select best invoices of BOPFs gained sharply, however the others were firm.

CTC Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s declined from last levels, the High and Medium sorts were irregularly dearer at times. Low Grown CTC PF1s were firm, the High and Medium sorts were firm to a little dearer.

Select best OP1s met with good demand, best and below best types too were dearer by Rs.100/- and more at times, secondaries were firm to dearer. Well-made OPs were firm, balance met with improved interest. Select best OPAs were firm, best and below best types appreciated Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, secondaries met with good demand. All BOP1s were firm to dearer. Well-made Pekoes met with good demand, best types along with the bolder types declined, mixed invoices met with lower demand. Shotty Pekoe1s were firm to selectively dearer, best and below best types declined, poorer sorts were lower.

All BOPs were lower to last. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs were firm to easier. BOPFs met with lower demand. Select best FBOPF1s were firm and others met with fair demand. All FBOPs were firm to selectively dearer. Tippy FBOPF varieties were firm, others met with irregular demand. Premium Flowery teas met with good demand.

Off Grades

Select best and best Fgs1s were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/- and more towards the closure, below best and poorer sorts maintained on last levels. Select best and best BMs were dearer by Rs.30/- to Rs.50/-, below best and poorer sorts were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Select best and best BPs maintained on last levels, below best and poorer varieties were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Select best BOP1As were lower by Rs.100/- to Rs.200/-, best types were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, below best types were higher by Rs.30/- to Rs.50/-, whilst poorer types were higher by Rs.40/- to Rs.80/-.

Dust

Select best and best Dust1s were firm to dearer, below best and poorer types were firm. All CTCs were firm on last. Select best and best Low Grown Dust / Dust1s were dearer by Rs.50/-, below best and poorer types were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-.

Crop intake is moderate.






The first sale of 2025 saw good general demand for the 159,957 packages (10,805,436.00 kilos) offered in the market with 19.81% remaining unsold.

MARKETS

Egyptian Packers, Kazakhstan and other CIS states were strong with Pakistan Packers active while Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries showed some support but at lower levels. Afghanistan maintained support while Bazaar were less active with maintained enquiry from UK; Russia were active but selective. Sudan showed good activity with South Sudan selective. China maintained participation with reduced enquiry from Local Packers. Somalia were active at the lower end of the market.

LEAF GRADES (M2 & M3)

BP1:

Best – Irregular and varied between firm to USC24 above previous rates with some lines up to USC48 dearer to easier by up to USC20 and some lines lost a further USC50.

Brighter - Irregular and varied between USC14 dearer to mostly easier shedding up to USC45.

Mediums – KTDA mediums saw good interest but at irregular rates ranging between USC20 dearer and some teas gained USC32, USC38, USC47, USC51 and USC68 to easier by up to USC10 with a few Invoices up to USC28 and USC40 below previous rates. Plantation mediums met strong enquiry appreciating by up to USC28 with selected invoices at USC112 above last levels.

Lower Medium - Met irregular support and ranged between USC24 above previous levels to USC16 below last rates.

Plainer – Were firm to dearer by up to USC22 but a few invoices lost up to USC4.

PF1:

Best – Steady to USC15 above previous levels with some invoices up to USC48 dearer to easier by up to USC13 with a few lines USC34 below last rates.

Brighter – Saw irregular enquiry and ranged USC7 dearer to easier by up to USC4.

Mediums – KTDA mediums met strong interest gaining USC19 with a few lines up to USC39 and USC47 dearer to easier by up to USC8. Plantation mediums were steady to USC9 dearer to easier by up to USC3.

Lower Medium – Firm to mostly dearer by up to USC14.

Plainer – Well competed for at steady to USC14 dearer to easier by up to USC7.

DUST GRADES (M1)

PDUST:

Best – Saw irregular enquiry and ranged between firm to USC22 dearer to easier by up to USC29.

Brighter – Were steady to USC18 above previous levels to easier by up to USC10.

Mediums – KTDA mediums met irregular interest and varied between USC24 dearer with some teas advancing by up to USC41, however some invoices were discounted by up to USC5 while others were USC39 below last levels. Plantation mediums irregularly appreciated by up to USC13.

Lower Medium – Met good absorption gaining up to USC24.

Plainer – Mostly appreciated by up to USC10 but some lines were up to USC7 below previous rates.



MOMBASA MARKET – Continued;

DUST1:

Best - Mostly dearer by up to USC17 but some teas lost up to USC3.

Brighter – Were dearer by up to USC23 with selected invoices easier by up to USC8.

Mediums – KTDA mediums saw irregular and easier interest, down by up to USC20 but a few lines gained with some invoices up to USC20 above last levels. Plantation mediums were firm to USC2 dearer to easier by up to USC7.

Lower Medium - Mostly dearer by up to USC32 to easier by USC6.

Plainer – Irregular and ranged between steady to USC15 dearer to easier by up to USC13.

SECONDARY GRADES (S1)

In the Secondary Catalogues, best BPs were firm while others gained with PFs steady. Clean well sorted coloury Fannings were firm while similar DUSTs tended dearer. Other Fannings held value with DUSTs about steady. BMFs were well absorbed.

BROKENS: Good liquoring Brokens were a good market particularly the GBOPs which were mostly firm over last. Other varieties were a little less in demand and were an easier market witnessing more withdrawals. BLF teas met with a selective demand with quite heavy withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Good liquoring Fannings were a good market and were firm to slightly dearer following competition. Medium and plainer sorts met with a fair demand but were easier in line with quality. BLF teas met with a selective demand with quite heavy withdrawals. BLF teas met with a selective demand with quite heavy withdrawals.

DUST: 11,967 packages of tea on offer met with a fair demand. Selective good liquoring Dusts sold well whilst others sold fairly well at easier rates. Mediums met with fair demand and sold at a drop of Tk.5/- to Tk.10/- closely following quality. Plain/BLF Dusts were a fair market with less withdrawals than last.. Blenders lent good support whilst Loose tea buyers were selective.

COMMENTS: A handful of good liquoring teas witnessed a good demand from both Blenders and Loose tea buyers. However, the bulk of the offerings were of plainer varieties which met with less demand at easier rates with more withdrawals. Blenders were more active this week whilst Loose tea buyers showed slightly more interest compared to last.

Good liquoring Dusts were the strong feature of the sale.
