


The 0.65Mkg of Ex estate teas on offer met with good demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs were firm. The below best and plainer varieties were firm to dearer. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs appreciated, the below best and plainer sorts too were tending dearer. Nuwara Eliya BOPs were firm, however the BOPFs were mostly unsold. Udapusellawa BOPs declined, the BOPFs were firm to irregular following quality. Uva BOPs were tending a little lower, the BOPFs were firm to dearer at times following quality. Low Grown CTC BP1s were firm, the High and Medium sorts were tending irregular. Low Grown CTC PF1s appreciated, the High and Medium sorts were firm.

The 2.1Mkg of Low Grown teas which were on offer met with good demand. Select best OP1s were dearer, best and below best varieties too followed a similar trend. Select best and best BOP1s met with strong demand. Select best and best OPs gained a few rupees, below best varieties too gained a few rupees. Well-made OPAs were dearer, below best varieties were firm. Bold Pekoes met with lower demand. Well-made Shotty Pekoe1s were firm, others declined a few rupees. In the Small Leaf segment, select best BOP.SP/BOPF.SP and BOPFs were dearer. Select best and best BOPs gained following quality. Select best and best FBOPs gained a few rupees, others too attracted fair interest. All FBOPF1s were dearer. FBOPF varieties maintained last levels. Premium Flowery teas were firm.

Russia, Iran and the C.I.S. countries lent good support whilst Turkey was selective. Libya and Iraq were active.

Western Teas

Select best BOPs were firm on last levels, the below best and plainer varieties were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Select best BOPFs were firm to Rs.10/- to Rs.20/- dearer following quality, the below best and plainer varieties too gained Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. Medium BOPs were firm on last levels, BOPFs gained Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOPs were firm on last levels, however the BOPFs mostly remained unsold.

Uva Teas

BOPs were tending a little easier, the BOPFs were firm to dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/- following quality. Udapussellawa BOPs declined by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, the BOPFs were irregular.

CTC Teas

Low Grown BP1s were firm, the High and Medium sorts were firm to irregularly dearer. Low Grown PF1s appreciated Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, the High Grown PF1s were firm, Medium Grown PF1s were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-.

Low Grown

Select best and best wiry OP1s gained from last levels, others too were firm to dearer. Better twisted BOP1s were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, bolder types too gained by a similar margin. Better twisted OPs maintained last levels, others too with a reasonable style gained by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. All OPAs met with fair demand and were mostly dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Well made Pekoes were firm, bold Pekoes met with irregular demand, reducer types were marginally lower. Shotty Pekoe1s were firm, others sold at last levels.

Select best well-made BOPs were dearer by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, best and below best types were firm, secondary types were dearer by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-. Select best and best BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with good demand, others were firm. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best and best FBOPF1s were substantially dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/- and more at times, others too were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Well-made FBOPs in the select best category were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, best types were dearer by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, below best and secondary types were firm. FBOPF varieties met with good demand. All Premium Flowery teas were firm.

Off Grades

Select best and best FGS1s were firm, below best and poorer types were easier by Rs.10/-. Select best and best BMs were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, below best and poorer types showed a similar trend. All BPs were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. All BOP1As maintained on last levels.

Dust

Select best and best Dust1s were irregularly dearer by Rs.5/-, below best types were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.15/-, poorer sorts appreciated by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-. Best High and Medium CTCs were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Low Grown CTCs met with fair demand and sold at last levels. Low Grown Dust/ Dust1s appreciated by Rs.10/-.

MOMBASA MARKET

SALE NO. 01 – SALE OF 04TH, 05TH & 06TH JANUARY 2022

Improved general demand for the 191,560 packages (12,665,465.00 kilos) in the market with 13.77% unsold.

LEAF GRADES

Offerings: 105,800 packages (6,960,388.00 kilos) and 14.01% remained unsold. The best BP1s available eased by USC10 to USC20 with brighter types fully firm to USC12 below previous week's levels and a few lines were unsold while medium varieties were firm to USC8 easier and many invoices remained unsold due to price limits. Improved lower medium categories held steady to USC26 above last prices but others shed USC4 to USC31 and some lines were unsold with plainer descriptions better absorbed varying between USC6 to USC36 dearer to easier by USC2 to USC10 and some teas remained without bids.

Best PF1s in the market gained USC3 to USC4 while brighter varieties appreciated by USC4 to USC5 with medium categories USC2 to USC20 above previous week's prices but many invoices were neglected due to price limits; lower medium types saw an irregular enquiry with improved lines advancing by USC2 to USC28 while others shed USC4 to USC15 and a few invoices were unsold. Plainer categories saw an irregular support ranging between steady to USC29 dearer to easier by USC2 to USC20 above previous week's used USC10 and some teas remained unsold.

DUST GRADES

Offerings: 56,580 packages (4,216,471.00 kilos). 6.72% remained unsold. The best PDUSTs available shed USC4 to USC15 while brighter categories were steady to USC20 below last rates with mediums irregular varying between firm to USC14 above last week's levels to easier by up to USC9 and some lines remained without bids due to price limits; improved lower medium types were well-competed for advancing by USC9 to USC29 while others were discounted by up to USC31. Plainer categories were irregular ranging between USC3 to USC10 dearer to easier by USC2 USC8 and a few lines remained unsold.

Best DUST1s on offer held value to USC12 dearer while brighter types varied between steady to USC3 above last rates to easier by up to USC2. Medium varieties met an irregular enquiry and ranged between firm to USC4 above previous week's levels to easier by USC9 to USC20; improved lower mediums saw better absorption at steady to US32 dearer while others eased by USC14 to USC25 and a few lines remained unsold. Plainer descriptions were irregular varying between USC5 to USC10 dearer to easier by USC2 to USC8 with a few invoices remained unsold.

SECONDARY GRADES.

Offerings: 29,180 packages (1,488,606.00 kilos) and 26.59% was unsold. In the Secondary Catalogues, BPs eased with PFs advancing. Well-sorted clean coloury Fannings were easier with similar DUSTs appreciating. Other Fannings and DUSTs were steady. BMFs saw better absorption at dearer rates.

MARKETS

Pakistan Packers showed more and strong support with increased interest from Kazakhstan, other CIS states, Bazaar and Sudan while Egyptian Packers lent strong and useful enquiry. There was good activity from Yemen, other Middle Eastern countries and Russia with UK active but at lower levels with some purchases for Iran. Afghanistan were subdued while Local Packers were less active in line with price. Somalia showed more interest at the lower end of the market.

CTC LEAF: 47,021 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a fairly good demand.

BROKENS: Good liquoring types met with quite strong demand and were mostly firm to slightly dearer. Medium varieties witnessed slightly more demand but were a little easier. Plainer varieties met with an irregular demand at generally slightly easier rates. BLF teas met with fair demand at around last levels.

FANNINGS: Good liquoring Fannings were again a strong market and were mostly dearer following competition. All other varieties were a fair market and tended slightly easier. BLF teas met with fair enquiry at around last levels.

CTC DUST: 10,345 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with quite a good demand. Good liquoring Dusts sold well at slightly dearer rates. Medium Dusts were fully firm on last. The plain and BLF Dusts were easier following a seasonal decline in quality. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: Demand continued to be fairly similar to last with good liquoring sorts again meeting strong competition at higher rates. Other varieties also met with quite fair enquiry but were generally a little easier with fair withdrawals. Blenders continued to be quite strong with quite good support from the Loose tea buyers.

Dusts sold well.


