The 0.73Mkg of Ex estate teas on offer met with fair demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs were firm to dearer. The below best and plainer varieties were mostly firm. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs were firm and gained selectively following quality. The below best and plainer varieties too which were firm at the commencement of the sale, appreciated as the sale progressed. Nuwara Eliya BOP/BOPFs were mostly unsold due to lack of suitable bids. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were dearer, the BOPFs too appreciated substantially towards the latter part of the sale. UVA BOPs were firm, the BOPFs too maintained last levels. The Low grown CTC BP1s were firm on last levels, the High and Medium sorts were irregular. Low Grown CTC PF1s gained marginally. The High and Medium PF1s were mostly firm on last levels.

The 2.3Mkg of Low Grown teas which were on offer met with good demand. In the Leafy segment, OPs were dearer, OPAs appreciated a few rupees. OP1s were mostly dearer. In the Semi Leafy segment, BOP1s were dearer. Pekoe varieties too were dearer. Pekoe1s were firm. In the Small Leaf segment, FBOPs were firm. FBOPF varieties continued to attract good demand. FBOPF1s were mostly firm. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOPs too met with fair demand. Select best Premium Flowery teas were lower to last, others were firm.

Turkey, Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.





MARKET DESCRIPTION

Western Teas

Select best BOPs were mostly firm with a few invoices appreciating following special inquiry, below best and plainer varieties too were mostly firm on last levels. Select best BOPFs were firm to irregularly dearer at times following quality, below best and plainer varieties were firm to Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- dearer at times. Medium BOPs were tending dearer, the BOPFs too appreciated Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOP / BOPFs were mostly unsold due to a lack of suitable bids.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs were firm, the BOPFs too were irregular following quality. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were irregularly dearer, the BOPFs too gained particularly towards the latter part of the sale.

CTC Teas

Low Grown BP1s appreciated Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, the High and Medium sorts were mostly firm. Low Grown PF1s were fully firm to a little dearer at times, the High and Medium sorts maintained last levels.

Low Grown

Select best wiry OP1s met with fair demand, other well-made OP1s too were firm to dearer, stalky secondaries met with good demand. Better twisted OPs gained from last week, below best sorts too met with fair demand. Select best OPAs were firm on last levels, best and below best sorts were firm to irregularly dearer. Better twisted BOP1s gained irregularly, bolder types were mainly firm. select best Pekoes along with the bold Pekoe invoices were mostly dearer, others too met with fair demand. Shotty Pekoe1s gained irregularly, secondaries were mainly firm.

Select best and best BOPs were firm, below best types were irregularly lower to last, secondary types were firm. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with fair demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best FBOPF1s were firm, best FBOPF1s were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, below best FBOPF1s were firm to easier by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, secondaries too were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. 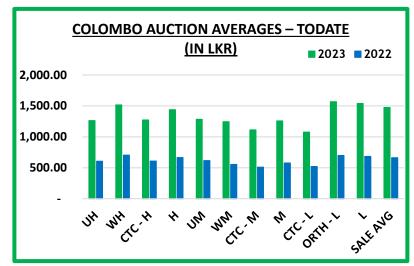


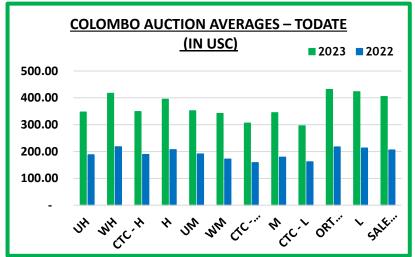

Crop intakes are moderate.

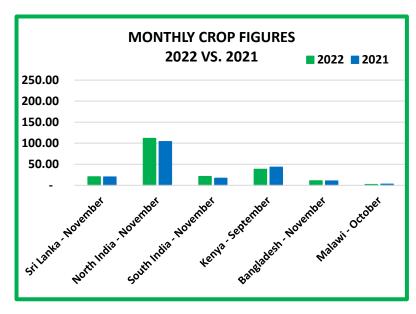


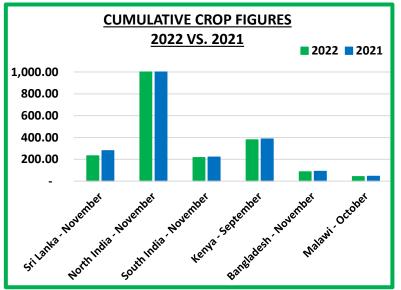

CIRCULAR NO.01 OF 2023 JANUARY 05, 2023

CATALOGUING RULES AND MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM PACKING DENSITIES

At the Committee Meeting held this afternoon, the following decisions were made on Cataloguing Rules and Minimum and Maximum Packing Densities.

Cataloguing Rules

Considering the low crops, with effect from the catalogues due to close on 12th of January 2023 (Sale No 5 – 30th/31st January 2023), the Cataloguing Rules have been changed as follows;

Main Sale Teas

A factory will be permitted to catalogue a maximum of 3 lots of any grade, in any combination of 10/15 bags or 20 bags or 30 bags.

Ex-Estate Sale

Factories selling in the Ex-Estate catalogue shall be permitted to offer a combination of 6 lots comprising of a maximum of 3x10 bags and 3x20 bags or 6x20 bags. This would be applicable for all grades.

CTC Teas

All CTC factories are permitted to catalogue a combination of 12 lots comprising of 3x10 bags and the remainder in 20 bag breaks of BP1 and PF1 grades in the Ex-Estate catalogue.

In addition, it should be noted that unlimited 40 bags lines are permitted to be catalogued in both Ex-Estate and Main Sale catalogues.

Please note that the rules are applied to the MF/BF/RT numbers and not on selling marks, per factory per sale.

This rule will be applicable up to and including Sale No 13 of 28th/29th March 2023, for which catalogues close on 9th of March 2023.

Grades Nomenclature with Corresponding Minimum and Maximum Packing Densities

We refer to the Circular No 48 of 2020 dated 9th October 2020 under the above caption.

It has been decided to amend the Circular where the minimum packing densities identified per grade has been removed until further notice.
