## **COMMENTS**



Today's 1.1 Mkgs of Ex-Estate teas on offer met with lower demand. Select best Western High Grown BOPs declined, the below best and plainer varieties too followed a similar trend. Select best Western High Grown BOPFs were easier from last week's levels with only a few selected teas holding firm. Nuwara Eliya BOPs were irregular and mostly easier, BOPFs too eased from last week's levels. Udapussellawa BOPs were easier, BOPFs were firm to a little easier at times. Uva BOP / BOPFs declined sharply. Low Grown CTC BP1s were firm, High and Medium sorts were irregular. Low Grown PF1s were marginally easier, High and Meidum sorts were irregularly lower following quality.

The 3.2 Mkg of Low Grown teas which were on offer met with fair demand. Select best and best OP1s were irregularly lower to last. BOP1s met with lower demand. Select best and best OP / OPAs were firm, secondaries met with reasonable demand. Well-made Bold Pekoes / Pekoe1s were dearer, best and below best types shed several Rupees. In the Small leaf segment, select best BOP.SP / BOPF.SP and BOPFs were firm. Select best BOPs were irregularly lower. Select best FBOPs declined several rupees, others were irregularly lower to last. Select best FBOPF1s were firm, others were lower to last. FBOPF varieties were lower. Well-made Premium Flowery teas were firm, others met with lower demand.

Turkey, Iran, Russia and the C.I.S. countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.







# **MARKET DESCRIPTION**

### **Western Teas**

Best BOPs shed Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- and at times more, below best types were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.50/-, plainer types declined by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. A few best BOPFs were firm, however the others declined by Rs.30/- to Rs.40/-, below best types shed Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, plainer sorts were easier by Rs.10/-. Medium BOPs shed Rs.20/-, BOPFs maintained.

## **Nuwara Eliya Teas**

BOP/ BOPFs declined on last levels.

### **Uva Teas**

BOPs were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, BOPFs declined by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Udapussellawa BOPs shed Rs.20/-, whilst the BOPFs were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-.

### **CTC Teas**

Low Grown BP1s maintained last levels, PF1s were slightly lower to last. Medium BP1/ PF1s were irregularly lower to last. High Grown BP1/ PF1s were firm.

# MARKET DESCRIPTION

### **Low Grown**

Well twisted wiry OP1s declined with only limited demand, bolder types along with the secondaries however held firm on most occasions. BOP1s were firm to easier by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Well-made OPs were firm to easier by a few rupees, secondaries however sold at attractive levels. OPAs maintained a similar market as OPs. Shotty Pekoes were firm, bold Pekoes eased by Rs.10/-. Well-made Pekoe1s in the select best category maintained last levels, others declined by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-.

Select best BOPs were firm, best and below best types were irregularly lower by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, secondary types were lower to last. Select best BOP.SP / BOPF.SPs were firm, best and below best types too were firm, poorer sorts were dearer by a few rupees. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best FBOPF1s were firm, best and below best types were lower by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, secondaries were lower by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, best types declined Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, below best and secondary types were firm. Select best FBOPF types were firm, best and below best types were lower to last. Select best Premium Flowery teas met with fair demand, best types met with lower demand, below best types were substantially lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-.

## **Off Grades**

Select best and best Fgs1s declined by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, below best and poorer sorts were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Select best and best BMs were dearer by Rs.10/-, whilst below best and poorer sorts were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. All BPs were dearer by Rs.30/- to Rs.40/-. Select best and best BOP1As were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, below best and poorer sorts showed a similar trend.

### **Dust**

Select best Dust1s declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, best and below best types declined by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, poorer sorts were firm to easier. Clean secondaries were firm to lower, others held firm. Best High and Medium CTCs declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, others declined by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Best Low Grown CTCs were lower by Rs.30/- to Rs.40/-, others were firm to lower. Best Low Grown Dust / Dust1s declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, others were dearer by Rs.20/-.

Crop intakes are low.






### **MOMBASA MARKET**

SALE NO. 03 – SALE OF 18<sup>TH</sup> / 19<sup>TH</sup> & 20<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 2021

Fair but irregular demand for the 156,689 packages (10,305,628.00 kilos) available. 16.01% remained without bids.

#### **LEAF GRADES**

Offerings: 76,240 packages (4,986,973.00 kilos). 11.44% were unsold. Best BP1s were a weak feature and eased up to USC28 but a few lines appreciated by up to USC2 while brighter varieties met strong enquiry and advanced by up to USC60 but some lines shed up to USC17 following quality. Medium types were discounted by USC9 to USC24 where sold with lower medium sorts about firm to USC2 easier and some lines remained unsold while plainer descriptions met an irregular interest and ranged between steady to USC10 above last prices to easier by up to USC6 with some invoices neglected.

The best PF1s on offer were irregular varying between steady to USC11 dearer following quality to easier by up to USC6 while brighter categories ranged between firm to USC8 above last prices to easier by up to USC6 with medium types irregular and varied between USC6 to USC10 dearer to easier by a similar rate. Lower mediums shed USC8 to USC20 with some invoices unsold while plainer categories were discounted by USC4 to USC10 where sold.

#### **DUST GRADES**

Offerings: 55,420 packages (4,087,824.00 kilos) with 23.31% remaining unsold. Best PDUSTs on offer shed USC6 to USC20 while brighter categories eased by USC6 to USC16 with medium varieties firm to USC14 below previous rates. Lower medium sorts held steady to USC5 easier and a few invoices were unsold with plainer descriptions irregular and varied between firm to USC5 dearer to easier by up to USC8 and some teas were neglected.

The best DUST1s in the market met improved interest advancing by USC10 to USC12 with brighter sorts easing by up to USC22 but a few improved lines gained up to USC3 while mediums were discounted by USC5 to USC28 but a few improved invoices appreciated by up to USC2. Lower medium types met an irregular enquiry varying between firm to USC6 dearer to easier by up to USC9 and some invoices received no bids with plainer categories ranging between steady to USC5 above last prices to easier by up to USC4 and many teas were neglected.

#### **SECONDARY GRADES.**

Offerings: 25,029 packages (1,230,831.00 kilos) and 13.78% remained without bids. In the Secondary Catalogues BPs were steady with PFs dearer. Clean well sorted coloury Fannings gained while similar DUSTs held value. Other Fannings appreciated with DUSTs steady. BMFs were well absorbed.

#### **MARKETS**

There was strong and useful enquiry from UK while Pakistan Packers, Yemen, other Middle Eastern countries and Sudan were active but at lower levels with Egyptian Packers active. Kazakhstan, other CIS nations, Russia and Bazaar reduced support with Afghanistan quieter while Iran were subdued. Local Packers showed some interest in line with price. Somalia maintained activity at the lower end of the market.

### CHITTAGONG MARKET

SALE NO. 35 - 25<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 2021

CTC LEAF: 33,921 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a fairly strong demand.

BROKENS: All good liquoring Brokens met with a fairly strong demand and were generally firm to occasionally dearer following competition. Medium varieties also met with quite a good demand and were mostly firm. Plain and BLF teas met with a fair demand and sold at around last levels.

FANNINGS: Best Fannings were again a strong market and sold well at mostly dearer rates following competition. Good and Mediums were also a good market and sold at around last levels. Plain and BLF teas were well supported at around last with some withdrawals.

CTC DUST: 8,997 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a fairly strong demand. Good liquoring teas sold well at easier rates particularly the CDs which were Tk.10/- to Tk.15/- lower than last week. Medium varieties were fully firm to a slightly dearer market. Plain and BLF teas met with less demand with fair withdrawals. Blenders lent strong demand with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: It was evident from the beginning of the sale that demand was quite strong although the competition from Blenders was not as wide-spread as in the last sale. The bright liquoring teas were fully firm to occasionally dearer but the lesser varieties which constituted larger portion of the offerings met with less competition and were generally a little easier as overall quality showed a seasonal decline over last week. Loose tea buyers operated at the lower end of the market.

CDs were an easier market.
