The 0.86Mkg of Ex-Estate teas on offer met with irregular demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs appreciated following special inquiry, the below best and plainer varieties were dearer from last week's levels. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs were barely steady, the below best and plainer varieties were firm to easier at times. Nuwara Eliya BOPs were dearer whilst the BOPFs gained from last levels. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were tending irregular, the BOPF were firm to dearer at times. UVA BOPs were irregular following quality, the BOPFs were mostly easier. Low Grown CTC BP1s were firm, the High and Medium sorts were firm to dearer at times. Low Grown CTC PF1s were firm on last levels, the High and Medium sorts were firm to irregularly dearer following quality.

The 2.6Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with good demand. In the Leafy segment, OP/OPA's were firm. OP1s gained following quality. BOP1s were lower to last. PEKOEs were lower, PEK1s were firm. In the Small Leaf segment, FBOPs were irregularly lower. FF1s were mostly firm. FF varieties were firm. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOP grades met with good demand. Premium flowery teas were selectively lower.

Turkey, Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.





MARKET DESCRIPTION

Western Teas

Select best BOPs appreciated following special inquiry, below best and plainer varieties too were dearer by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- and more. Select best BOPFs were barely steady and mostly easier, below best and plainer sorts too were Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- easier on average. Medium BOPs sold well and were firm to a little dearer at times, the BOPFs were firm on last levels.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOPs were dearer following quality, the BOPFs too were dearer.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs were irregular following quality, the BOPFs were mostly easier. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were tending irregular, the BOPFs were firm to Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- dearer at times.

CTC Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s were firm on last levels, the High and Medium sorts were firm to little dearer. Low Grown PF1s were firm, the High and Medium sorts were firm to Rs.50/- to 100/-dearer at times.

MARKET DESCRIPTION



Low Grown

Select best OP1s maintained firm levels, best types appreciated and met with good demand, secondaries too were mostly dearer. Well-made OPs were firm, others gained irregularly. Select best OPAs were firm, balance appreciated from last levels. In the Semi Leafy segment, select best BOP1s were lower to last, bolder types were firm to dearer. Well-made Pekoes declined slightly, bold Pekoes met with irregular demand and were mostly lower to last, secondaries maintained. Shotty Pekoe1s were mostly firm, others too met with fair demand.

Select best BOPs were firm, best types were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.50/-, below best and secondary types were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.50/-. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with fair demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best and best FBOPF1s were firm to dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.50/- and more following quality, below best types were firm on last, secondary types gained following quality. Select best and best FBOPs were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/- and more at times, below best types were easier by Rs.40/- to Rs.50/-, secondary types were firm. FF varieties were firm. All Premium Flowery teas were lower to last.

Off Grades

Select best and best Fgs1s were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, below best and poorer sorts were firm to dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Select best and best BMs were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, whilst below best and poorer types maintained on last levels. Select best and best BPs maintained on last levels, whilst below best and poorer varieties were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Select best BOP1As were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, best types were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.60/-, below best types maintained on last levels, whilst poorer sorts were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.50/-.

Dust

Select best and best Dust1s were firm to dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, below best and poorer types were firm. High and Medium CTCs were firm. Low Grown CTCs declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Low Grown Dust / Dust1s were firm.

Crop intakes are low.






Fair general demand for the 290,759 packages (19,491,725.00 kilos) available in the market with 46.13% unsold.

OFFERINGS

Leaf Grades	-	174,800 packages (11,499,625.00 kilos) – 55.34% unsold.
Dust Grades	-	86,320 packages (6,458,351.00 kilos) – 38.53% unsold.
Secondary Grades	-	29,639 packages (1,533,749.00 kilos) – 13.90% unsold.

MARKETS

There was improved interest from Egyptian Packers while Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries maintained support. Pakistan Packers and Bazaar were active at lower levels with Kazakhstan, other CIS states and Afghanistan showing reduced enquiry. UK and South Sudan maintained interest with Local Packers more active. Russia, Iran and Sudan were absent while Somalia were active at the lower end of the market.

LEAF GRADES (M2)

BP1:

Best – Were mostly steady to easier by up to USC43 with select teas discounted by USC53 but a few lines advanced by up to USC53.

Brighter – Firm to USC10 dearer to easier by up to USC36.

Mediums – KTDA mediums held value where sold while plantation mediums ranged between firm to USC34 dearer to easier by up to USC20.

Lower Medium – Were irregular at steady to USC10 dearer to mainly easier by up to USC28.

Plainer – Saw improved activity and appreciated by up to USC28 but a few teas lost up to USC20.

<u> PF1:</u>

Best – Varied between firm to USC38 above previous levels for some lines with select invoices gaining USC73 to mostly easier by up to USC20.

Brighter – Were steady to USC17 below last prices.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were irregular ranging between firm to USC8 dearer to easier by up to USC6 with plantation mediums varying between USC10 dearer to USC18 below previous rates.

Lower Medium – Ranged between steady to USC27 dearer with selected teas advancing by USC40 to USC46 to easier by up to USC17.

Plainer – Were irregular with some teas appreciating by up to USC27 while others shed up to USC19.

DUST GRADES (M1)

PDUST:

Best – Most teas appreciated by up to USC25 but some teas eased by up to USC16.

Brighter – Irregular varying between steady to USC17 dearer to easier by up to USC14.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were firm to USC9 above previous levels to USC4 easier; plantation mediums were steady to easier by up to USC20.

Lower Medium – Ranged between steady to USC17 dearer to easier by up to USC10.

Plainer - Saw improved enquiry and advanced by up to USC9, some lines however eased by up to USC6.





MOMBASA MARKET – Continued ;

DUST1:

Best – Were well competed for at firm to USC42 dearer with selected teas appreciating by USC66.
Brighter – Saw irregular interest varying between steady to USC10 dearer to easier by up to USC15.
Mediums – KTDA mediums varied between firm to USC14 dearer to USC10 below last prices with plantation mediums ranging between USC20 dearer to easier by up to USC16.
Lower Medium – Were irregular varying between steady to USC15 dearer and select lines gained up to USC45 to easier by up to USC10.
Plainer – Gained up to USC20 but a few teas lost up to USC9.

SECONDARY GRADES (S1)

In the Secondary Catalogues, **BPs** were firm while **PFs** tended easier. Clean well sorted coloury **Fannings** were dearer with **similar DUSTs** appreciating. **Other Fannings** held value with **DUSTs** steady. **BMFs** were well absorbed.

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CHITTAGONG MARKET SALE NO. 40 – 29TH JANUARY 2024

CTC LEAF: 51,853 packages of tea were on offer. Strong demand continued.

BROKENS: Clean liquoring Brokens were strongly competed for and prices appreciated by Tk.5/- and more. Mediums were also a fairly strong feature and were about firm. Plain teas met with a little more interest but prices were about steady with several withdrawals. BLF teas saw some demand at about steady rates. However, there were heavy withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Clean Fannings were again a strong feature and often appreciated following quality. Mediums witnessed a good demand and were about steady. Plain teas met with a little more interest at about steady rates. There were several withdrawals in this category. BLF teas saw some demand at about steady rates. However, there were heavy withdrawals.

DUST: 16,442 packages of tea on offer met with good demand. Good liquoring Dusts were a fair market and sold Tk.3/- to Tk.5/- less than last with fewer withdrawals. Mediums were an easier market with some withdrawals. Plain and BLF Dusts were an easier market with some withdrawals and sold Tk. 5/- to Tk.8/- less than last. Blenders were active whilst Loose tea buyers were also fairly active.

COMMENTS: Blenders operated in greater strength this week particularly for the bright varieties. Loose tea buyers were also more active.

Dusts were once again an easier market but withdrawals were less.
