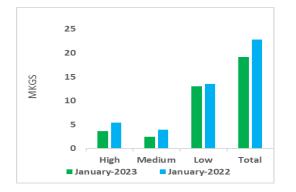




Sri Lanka harvested a crop of 19.1Mkg during the Month of January 2023, which is a negative variance of 16.1% when compared to the crop harvested in January 2022. Incidentally, this is the lowest production reported for the month of January since the year 1992, which was 17.2Mkg.

The main contributor for the 19.1Mkg was from the Low Grown planting districts with 68.3%, followed by High Growns at 18.8% and the Medium Growns at 12.9%. When compared with the crop in January 2022, negative variances have been recorded in the High Growns at 34%, Low Growns at 3% and the Medium Growns at 37%.

The 0.73Mkg of Ex-Estate teas on offer met with irregular demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs gained selectively, the below best and plainer varieties were firm to easier at times. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs gained following quality and special inquiry, the below best and plainer varieties were firm on last levels. Nuwara Eliya BOPs gained following special inquiry, the BOPF too were irregularly dearer. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were irregularly lower , the BOPFs were irregular following quality. Uva BOPs /BOPFs were mostly firm on last levels. Low grown CTC BP1s were firm, the High and Medium sorts were irregular. Low Grown CTC PF1s were marginally easier, the High and Medium sorts maintained last levels.

The 2.4Mkg of Low Grown teas which were on offer met with fair demand. In the Leafy segment, OPA's were irregularly dearer, OPs were mostly firm. OP1s met with fair demand. In the Semi Leafy segment, BOP1s were substantially lower. Pekoe/Pek-1 varieties were lower to last. In the Small Leaf segment, FBOPs were lower to last. FBOPF/FF1 varieties continued to experience lower demand. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOP grades too met with lower interest. Premium Flowery teas were lower.

Turkey, Russia and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Iran was very selective. Libya and Iraq were active.





Western Teas

Select best BOPs gained selectively by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, the below best and plainer varieties were firm to Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- easier at times. Select best BOPFs gained Rs.100/- and more following quality and special inquiry, the below best and plainer varieties were firm to Rs.50/- lower at times. Medium BOPs were firm to a little dearer, the BOPFs maintained last levels.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOPs gained irregularly, the BOPFs too were tending dearer.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs were irregularly lower, the BOPFs were firm to Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- easier. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were irregularly easier, the BOPFs too were mostly firm.

CTC Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s were firm, High and Medium sorts were irregular. Low Grown CTC PF1s were tending easier by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, the High and Medium sorts too were firm.

MARKET DESCRIPTION

Low Grown

Select best wiry OP1s were firm, other well-twisted OP1s too along with the bolder types maintained last levels. Better twisted OPs were mostly firm, others met with mixed demand. Well-made OPAs gained irregularly, others were firm on last levels. Select best BOP1s along with the best types declined sharply, others too were mostly lower. Well-made Pekoes along with the bolder types were firm to marginally easier, others were lower to last. Shotty Pekoe1s were firm to easier, others maintained last levels.

Select best and best BOPs were lower to last by Rs.30/- to Rs.50/- with lower demand, below best types too were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, secondary types were firm. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with lower demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best and best FBOPF1s were lower by Rs.50/- to Rs.60/-, below best FBOPF1s too were lower by Rs.30/- to Rs.40/-, secondaries were firm. Well-made FBOPs in the select best category were firm to lower by a few rupees, best and below best types were lower by Rs.50/- to Rs.60/- and more following quality, secondaries were firm. FBOPF varieties met with lower demand. All Premium Flowery teas were lower by Rs.50/- to Rs.50

Off Grades

Select best and best FGS1s declined by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, below best and poorer types were firm. Select best and best BMs were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, below best and poorer types were firm. Select best and best BPs were firm, below best and poorer types showed an irregular demand. Select best BOP1As maintained on last levels whilst, best BOP1As were dearer by Rs.50/- to Rs.60/- and more at times , below best and poorer sorts also maintained on last levels.

Dust

Select best and best Dust1s appreciated by Rs.10/- to Rs.15/-, below best and poorer sorts were dearer by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-. High and Medium CTCs appreciated Rs.05/- to Rs.10/-. Low Grown CTCs were dearer by Rs.10/-. Low Grown Dust/Dust1s declined by Rs.10/- to Rs.15/- and more as the sale progressed.

Good and improved demand for the 242,022 packages (16,269,167.00 kilos) on offer with 32.91% remaining unsold.

OFFERINGS

Leaf Grades	-	130,720 packages (8,588,669.00 kilos) – 33.05% unsold.
Dust Grades	-	84,080 packages (6,287,626.00 kilos) – 39.44% unsold.
Secondary Grades	-	27,222 packages (1,392,872.00 kilos) – 12.12% unsold.

MARKETS

Afghanistan and Egyptian Packers lent strong support and were dominant with Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries more active. Sudan, UK, Russia, Kazakhstan and other CIS states maintained enquiry while Iran and Pakistan Packers showed selective interest. Bazaar were quiet while Local Packers maintained activity. Somalia were active at the lower end of the market.

LEAF GRADES (M2)

BP1:

Best – Were irregular with some teas advancing by up to USC29 while others were discounted by up to USC24 and select invoices lost up to USC103.

Brighter – Saw reduced competition and were firm to USC26 below previous levels.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were steady to USC10 easier while plantation mediums lost up to USC26 but a few lines gained by up to USC14.

Lower Mediums – Met good but irregular interest and ranged between firm to USC20 dearer with a few invoices gaining USC30 to USC40 to easier by USC15. Plainer – Were steady to dearer by up to USC16.

<u> PF1:</u>

Best – Saw improved but irregular activity varying between firm to USC40 dearer for most teas to easier by up to USC18.

Brighter – Appreciated by up to USC20.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were firm to USC15 dearer but a few lines shed up to USC6; plantation mediums advanced by up to USC7 and select teas were dearer by USC26 but a few invoices lost up to USC8.

Lower Mediums – Were irregular varying between USC16 dearer to easier by up to USC18.

Plainer – Ranged between steady to USC23 dearer to easier by up to USC12.

DUST GRADES (M1)

PD

Best – Ranged between steady to USC20 above previous levels to easier by up to USC16.

Brighter – Were firm to USC15 dearer.

STORAGE CHARGES FOR COLOMBO WAREHOUSES

Considering the overall escalation in cost, the Committee at its meeting held on February 02, 2023, decided to revise current storage charges for warehouses detailed in By-law 33 as follows;

- The current rate is Rs.3.25 per package per day commencing from the 22nd day until the 60th day revised to Rs. 3.75 per package per day.
- 61st day onwards and until and including the day on which the Buyer takes delivery of the tea, the current rate of Rs.10.40 per package per day is revised to Rs. 12.00 per package per day.

The above-revised charges will be effective from February 01.2023.
