Bright Western High Grown BOPs sold well following special inquiry, other good invoices were irregular following quality, the below best and plainer varieties were firm. Bright Western High Grown BOPFs advanced following special inquiry, other good coloury invoices too were dearer, the below best and plainer sorts were marginally dearer. Nuwara Eliya BOPs were irregular following quality, the BOPFs too followed a similar trend. Udapussellawa BOP / BOPFs were firm on last levels. Uva BOPs were dearer following special inquiry, the BOPFs were firm to a little dearer at times. Low Grown CTC BP1s were mostly firm on last levels, High and Medium sorts were barely steady. Low Grown PF1s were easier from last week's levels, High and Medium sorts were barely steady.

The 2.8Mkgs of Low Grown teas which were on offer met with good demand. Select best and best OP1s were firm, others met with irregular demand. Select best and best BOP1s sold at last week's closing levels. Select best and best OPAs gained a few rupees, others too met with improved demand. Best OPs were firm, others were irregular. Well-made bold Pekoes were dearer. Shotty Pekoe1s maintained last levels. In the Small Leaf segment, select best BOP.SP / BOPF.SP and BOPFs were firm. Select best BOPs were irregularly lower to last. Select best FBOPs met with fair demand, others were irregularly lower to last. Select best and best FBOPF varieties were lower. Well-made Premium Flowery teas were firm to dearer, others met with good demand.

Turkey, Iran, Russia and the C.I.S. countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.



MARKET DESCRIPTION

Western Teas

Bright Western High Grown BOPs appreciated Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- and at times more on account of special inquiry, the balance met with irregular demand, below best types met with fair demand but were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/- at times, plainer sorts maintained last levels. Bright liquoring BOPFs appreciated Rs.20/- to Rs.30/- and at times more along with some of the select best coloury sorts. However, the below best and plainer sorts were firm to marginally dearer at times. Better Medium BOPs appreciated Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, the balance maintained last levels, BOPFs appreciated Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, the balance

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOP / BOPF appreciated selectively following special inquiry.

Uva Teas

Better BOPs appreciated Rs.30/- to Rs.40/-, whilst the others maintained. A few better BOPFs appreciated Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, whilst the others were firm. Udapussellawa BOPs and BOPFs maintained.

CTC Teas

A few Low Grown BP1s appreciated Rs.10/- to Rs.20/, the balance barely maintained, PF1s were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. Medium Grown BP1s barely maintained last levels, PF1s were lower by Rs.10/-. High Grown BP1s met with irregular demand, the PF1s were firm.

Low Grown

Select best wiry OP1s along with the other well twisted invoices gained by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, secondaries too experienced good demand. Wellmade BOP1s were firm to dearer, bolder types gained from last week's closing levels. OPs in the select best and best categories met with good demand and absorbed prices above last week, secondaries too were firm to dearer. Well-made OPAs gained by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, secondaries gained by a similar margin on most occasions. Shotty Pekoes were firm, bold Pekoes were firm to dearer and had good demand, secondary types gained irregularly. Well-made Pekoe1s were firm, others were firm to dearer by Rs.10/-.

Select best BOPs met with fair demand, best and below best types were firm, secondary types were dearer by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-. Select best BOP.SP / BOPF.SPs were firm, best and below best types too were firm, poorer sorts were dearer by a few rupees. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best FBOPF1s were firm to irregularly lower by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, best and below best types were firm, secondaries were dearer by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-. Select best were firm, secondaries were firm to dearer by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, best and bold types were irregularly lower by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-. and more at times, below best types too were lower by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, secondary types were firm. Select best FBOPF varieties were firm, others were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/- with lower demand. Select best Premium Flowery teas met with reasonable demand, others met with irregular demand.

Off Grades

Select best and best Fgs1s declined by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, below best and poorer sorts were easier by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-. Select best and best BMs were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.15/-, below best and poorer sorts appreciated Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-. Select best and best BPs were firm whilst below best and poorer types declined by Rs.10/-. Select best BOP1As held firm whilst best types were irregularly dearer, below best BOP1As were firm to dearer whilst poorer sorts held firm.

Dust

Select best Dust1s were firm to easier, best and below best types were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, clean secondaries were firm to dearer by Rs.10/-, others were irregular. Best High & Medium CTCs were lower by Rs.10/-, others followed a similar trend. Best Low Grown CTCs were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, others were irregular. Best Low Grown Dust / Dust1s were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, others were irregular.

Crop intakes are low.






MOMBASA MARKET

SALE NO. 07 - SALE OF 15TH / 16TH & 17TH FEBRUARY 2021

Strong general demand prevailed for the 214,313 packages (14,094,128.50 kilos) in the market. 9.04% were unsold.

LEAF GRADES

Offerings: 97,180 packages (6,340,975.00) with 8.27% unsold. Best BP1s on offer met improved and strong support gaining USC7 to USC54 closely following quality while brighter varieties were a weak feature and eased by USC5 to USC84 and substantially more below previous week's levels. Mediums were irregular ranging between USC2 to USC10 above last prices to easier by USC2 to USC6 with lower medium types steady to USC10 dearer, but a few invoices shed up to USC4 where sold. Plainer descriptions saw an irregular enquiry with improved lines advancing by USC2 to USC24 while others eased by USC2 to USC8 and some lines remained without interest.

The best PF1s in the market held firm to USC8 easier with brighter categories appreciating by USC4 to USC8 while medium types were steady to USC10 above last rates. Lower medium sorts held steady to USC10 dearer but a few invoices remained without bids with plainer categories gaining USC2 to USC10 but a few teas were neglected.

DUST GRADES

83,640 packages (6,084,770.00 kilos. 9.71% were unsold. Best PDUSTs available were firm to USC22 dearer closely following quality but a few lines shed up to USC4 while brighter sorts ranged between firm to USC10 above last prices to easier by up to USC2; mediums varied between steady to USC4 dearer to easier by up to USC6. Lower medium categories were strongly competed for appreciating by USC8 to USC16 with plainer sorts steady to USC12 above previous week's rates and a few lines were unsold.

The best DUST1s in the market advanced by USC2 to USC7 with brighter types easing by USC2 to USC12 but a few improved invoices gained up to USC8 while medium varieties were steady to USC10 below last prices. Lower medium categories held firm to USC10 dearer, but some lines remained without bids while plainer types were steady to USC5 above previous levels with some teas remaining unsold.

SECONDARY GRADES.

Offerings: 33,493 packages (1,668,384.00 kilos) and 9.61% remained without bids. In the Secondary Catalogues, best BPs appreciated while others held value with PFs dearer. Clean well sorted coloury Fannings gained while similar DUSTs were easier. Other Fannings were dearer while DUSTs declined. BMFs were well absorbed.

MARKETS

Egyptian Packers lent more and strong support and were forceful with strong enquiry from Pakistan Packers while UK, Bazaar and Afghanistan showed more interest. Kazakhstan and other CIS nations lent useful activity but were selective while Sudan were active. There was reduced interest from Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries with Russia active but selective while Iran were selective. Local Packers showed some support on account of price. Somalia were active at the lower end of the market.

CHITTAGONG MARKET SALE NO. 39 - 22nd FEBRUARY 2021

CTC LEAF: 30,347 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a better demand although prices eased a little.

BROKENS: A few good Brokens on offer were a fairly strong feature of the sale and were mostly firm to a touch dearer whilst other descriptions were about steady on last with a few withdrawals. Plain and BLFs met with fair interest and were a touch easier with some withdrawals.

FANNINGS: There was only a handful of clean Fannings on offer which met with a fairly good demand but the most were a little easier. Medium Fannings were less in demand and were easier with quality. There was also more withdrawals in this category. Plain types witnessed a fair demand but at lower rates and saw some withdrawals.

CTC DUST: 8,014 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a fairly good demand. Good liquoring Dusts were easier by Tk.5/- to Tk.10/- closely following quality. Mediums were about steady. However, plain and BLF Dusts were fully firm to slightly dearer with less withdrawals compared to last. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: There was a preponderance of plain and end of season teas in this sale and inspite of that there was a fair interest from the Blenders particularly for the cleaner varieties whilst the Loose Tea buyers were also more active especially for the clean teas but at a lower price level.

Dusts sold well.
