The Auction averages for the month of February 2023 recorded at Rs.1,438.20, is an increase of Rs.712.57 in comparison to February 2022 which was at Rs.725.63. When analyzing the respective elevations, the High Growns recorded an average of Rs.1,402.55 which is a positive variance of Rs.706.07 in comparison to Rs.696.48 in February last year. Medium Growns too recorded a positive variance of Rs.612.19 with an average of Rs.1,257.27 when compared to Rs.645.08 in February 2022. Similarly, a positive variance of Rs.730.54 was also recorded in the Low Growns with an average of Rs.1,489.99 in comparison to Rs.759.45 in February 2022.

Due to the strengthening of the Sri Lankan Rupee against the US Dollar over the past few days, this week's tea auction prices recorded a decline in keeping with the prevailing exchange rate.

The 0.71Mkg of Ex-Estate teas on offer met with fair demand at lower levels. A few Select Best Western High Grown BOPs sold well following special inquiry, whilst other good invoices declined sharply, the below best and plainer varieties too were easier however, to a lesser extent. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs declined sharply, the below best and plainer varieties too were easier. Nuwara Eliya BOPs declined, the limited quantity of BOPFs declined from last levels. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were barely steady, the BOPFs eased from last week's levels with a few invoices remaining firm. Uva BOPs /BOPFs declined from last week's levels. Low grown CTC BP1s tended easier, the High and Medium sorts were irregular. Low Grown CTC PF1s declined sharply, the High and Medium sorts too were easier.

The 2.4Mkg of Low Grown teas which were on offer met with lower demand. In the Leafy segment, OP/OPA's were lower to last. Few selected OP1s met with reasonable demand, BOP1 too followed a similar trend. PEK/PEK-1's were substantially lower. In the Small Leaf segment, FBOPs were lower to last. FBOPF/FF1 varieties continued to experience lower demand. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOP grades too met with lower interest. Premium Flowery teas were lower.

Turkey, Russia and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Iran was very selective. Libya and Iraq were active.





Western Teas

Select best BOPs mostly declined by Rs.100/- to Rs.200/-, the below best and plainer varieties too followed a similar trend. Select best BOPFs declined sharply by Rs.200/- to Rs.300/-, the below best sorts were easier by Rs.200/- whilst the plainer varieties eased to a lesser extent. Medium BOPs were substantially easier, the BOPFs too declined by Rs.200/- to Rs.300/- on average.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOPs declined by Rs.200/- to Rs.300/-, the BOPFs too declined by a similar margin.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs declined by Rs.100/- and more, the BOPFs declined by Rs.100/to Rs.200/- on average. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were easier by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, the BOPFs too declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- and at times, a few invoices remained firm on last levels.

CTC Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s were easier, the High and Medium sorts too were irregularly lower. Low Grown CTC PF1s declined by Rs.200/- to Rs.300/-, the High and Medium sorts too were easier by Rs.100/- to Rs.150/-.

MARKET DESCRIPTION

Low Grown

Select best OP1s met with reasonable demand, other wiry OP1s were mostly lower, bolder types declined by Rs.150/- on average. Well-made OPs tended lower and declined by Rs.100/- to Rs.150/- and more as the sale progressed, secondaries too declined by Rs.100/-. Well-made OPAs declined by Rs.100/- to Rs.150/- and more at times, clean secondaries too eased by a similar margin. BOP1s were substantially lower. Well-made Pekoes along with the bold Pekoe invoices declined by Rs.100/- to Rs.150/-, secondaries too met with lower demand. Shotty Pekoe1s eased by Rs.100/-, secondaries were lower to last.

Select best and best BOPs were lower to last by Rs.100/- to Rs.150/- with lower demand, below best and secondary types too were lower by Rs.80/- to Rs.100/-. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with very low demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. All FBOPF1s were substantially lower by Rs.150/- to Rs.200/- and more following quality. Well-made FBOPs in the select best category were lower by Rs.100/- to Rs.150/-, best and below best types were lower by Rs.80/- to Rs.100/- and more following quality. FBOPF varieties met with lower demand. All Premium Flowery teas were substantially lower.

Off Grades

Select best, best and below best FGS1s showed a sharp decline by Rs.200/-, poorer types declined by Rs.50/-. Select best and best BMs declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/-, below best and poorer types declined by Rs.50/-. All BPs declined by Rs.100/- and more towards the closure. Select best BOP1As were lower by Rs.200/- to Rs.250/- whilst best BOP1As were lower by Rs.150/- to Rs.200/-, below best and poorer sorts were also lower by Rs.100/- to Rs.150/- and more at times.

Dust

Select best and best Dust1s were lower by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, below best and poorer sorts depreciated by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/- and more at times as the sale progressed. High and Medium CTCs depreciated by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Low Grown CTCs were lower by Rs.15/- to Rs.20/-. Low Grown Dust/ Dust1s depreciated by Rs.20/- and more at times.

CATALOGUING RULES AND MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM PACKING DENSITIES

Reference Circular No 01of 2023 dated January 5, 2023, the following should be noted;

Main Sale Teas

A factory will be permitted to catalogue a maximum of 3 lots of any grade, in any combination of 10/15 bags or 20 bags or 30 bags (excluding Dust1's, PD's and Premium Flowery grades).

PD and Dust 1 (High, Mid and Low Growns)

A factory is permitted to catalogue a maximum of 3 lots of 10 bags and 3 lots of 20 bags. There is no restriction on 40 bag lines.

PD / Dust 1 will be treated as one grade, applicable to CTC factories.

Premium Flowery

No change in the current cataloging rules for FFSp, FFExSp and FFExSp1.

We reiterate that the rules are applied to the MF/BF/RT numbers and not on selling marks, per factory per sale.

Rules will be applicable up to and including Sale No 13 of 28th/29th March 2023, for which catalogues close on 9th of March 2023.

There are no other amendments/changes to CTTA Circular No 01 of 2023.
