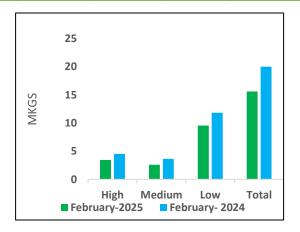
COMMENTS

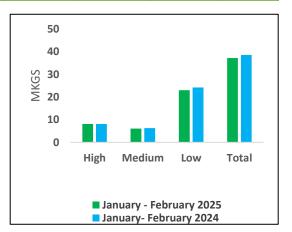


Sri Lanka harvested a crop of 15.5Mkg during the Month of February 2025, which is a decline of 22% when compared to the crop harvested in February 2024. Incidentally, this is the lowest production recorded for the month of February, since the year 2009 which was at 12.5Mkg.

The main contributor for the 15.5Mkg was from the Low Grown planting districts with 61.3%, followed by High Growns at 22.1% and the Medium Growns at 16.6%. When compared with the crop in February 2024, negative variances were recorded in the Medium Growns at 29 %, High Growns at 24% and the Low Growns at 19%.

COMMENTS – Cont'd....



Tea Exports for the month of February 2025 was recorded at 20.3Mkg which is a decline of 8.5% when compared with the same period of the previous year. The average unit FOB value per kg. was Rs.51.91 below the average unit value per kg in February 2024. The cumulative Export quantity for the year recorded a negative variance of 1.3Mkg against the corresponding period. The cumulative average FOB value recorded a decline of Rs.40.58 against last year's average FOB price. Therefore, the value of Tea Exports for the period (January- February) in 2025 recorded a negative variance of Rs.3.9 billion in comparison to the previous year. Iraq emerged as the leading importer of Sri Lanka Tea followed by other major importers such as Russia, Libya, U.A.E and Turkey.

0.93Mkg of Ex- Estate teas on offer met with irregularly lower demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs appreciated selectively following special inquiry, the others along with the below best and plainer varieties were irregularly lower. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs barely maintained last week's levels and were tending irregularly lower, the below best and plainer varieties were tending irregular, with only a few invoices appreciating from last levels. Nuwara Eliya BOPs were mostly easier, the BOPFs were irregular following quality. Uda Pussellawa BOPs mostly remained unsold, the BOPFs were barely steady with some invoices remaining unsold due to lack of suitable bids. Uva BOPs/ BOPF were tending easier. Low Grown CTC BP1s mostly remained unsold, whilst the High and Medium sorts were irregular. Low Grown CTC PF1s maintained last levels, the medium sorts were irregular, the High Growns maintained.

The 1.9Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with fair demand. In the Leafy segment, Well-made OPs/OPAs were lower to last, others gained irregularly. Select best and best OP1s were lower, others were firm to dearer. BOP1s were firm to easier. PEKOEs were firm on last. Shotty PEKOE1s were firm, others declined from last levels. In the Small Leaf segment, FBOPs were lower to last. FBOPF1s were firm to easier. The BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOPSP and BOPs were lower to last. FBOPF varieties were firm on last. Premium Flowery teas met with fair demand.

Turkey, Russia and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.





MARKET DESCRIPTION

Western Teas

Select best Western High Grown BOPs were irregularly easier, only a few invoices gained Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- following special inquiry, the below best and plainer varieties were mostly easier. Select best Western High Grown BOPFs declined Rs.100/- and more with only a few invoices maintaining last levels, below best and plainer varieties were firm to a little dearer by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/- at times, however the others declined irregularly. Medium BOPs barely maintained, the BOPFs too were tending easier.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOPs were mostly easier, the BOPFs were irregular following quality.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs were tending easier by Rs.50/- and more, the BOPFs declined Rs.50/- to Rs.80/-. Uda Pussellawa BOPs mostly remained unsold, the BOPFs were barely steady and some invoices remained unsold due to a lack of suitable bids.

CTC Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s mostly remained unsold, the High and Medium sorts were irregular. Low Grown CTC PF1s maintained last levels, Medium sorts were irregular, High Grown sorts too maintained.

Low Grown

Select best and best OP1s declined sharply from last levels, below best sorts were firm, secondaries were firm to dearer with demand further improving towards the conclusion of the Sale. Well-made OP/ OPAs were easier, below best sorts gained from last levels. Select best BOP1s were firm, best types met with irregular demand, bolder mixed types were lower to last. Well-made Pekoes were firm, best types along with the bolder types were firm to marginally dearer. Shotty Pekoe1s were firm to easier, best types met with good demand, poorer, mixed types were irregular.

Select best and best BOPs were easier and the others were firm. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs were firm. BOPFs in general were easier. Select best FBOPF1s were firm whilst the best and cleaner below best teas were firm to dearer, the rest were irregular. Select best FBOPs were firm whilst the best and below best together with the bolder types were lower to last. Select best FBOPF varieties were firm whilst the best and below best types were firm to dearer. Premium Flowery teas met with fair demand.

Off Grades

Select best FGS1s were lower by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, best types were firm on last levels, below best and poorer sorts maintained on last levels. Select best and best BMs were firm on last levels. below best and poorer sorts appreciated by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Select best and best BPs were dearer by Rs. 20/- to Rs.30/-, below best and poorer varieties were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Select best BOP1As maintained on last levels, best types were lower by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/-, below best types maintained on last levels, whilst poorer types were higher by Rs.30/- to Rs.40/-.

Dust

Select best and best Dust1s were firm, below best and poorer types were dearer by Rs.20/-. Low Grown CTCs declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. High and Medium CTCs were firm on last. Select best and best Low Grown Dust / Dust1s were firm, below best and poorer types declined by Rs. 20/- to Rs.40/- and more.

Crop intake is moderate.

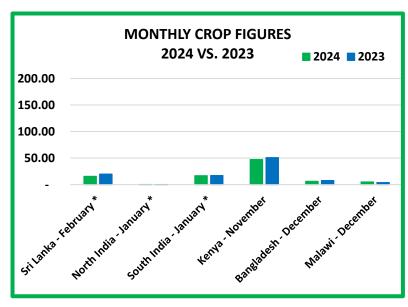


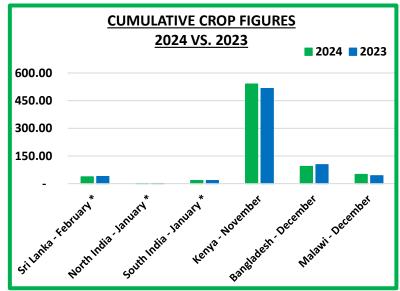
