The total sale average at the previous week's auction was Rs.1,123.62 which is the highest average recorded thus far at a weekly auction and the first time it surpassed Rs.1000/-.

The Auction averages for the month of March 2022 recorded at Rs.848.08, which shows an increase of Rs.193.76 in comparison to the 2021 March figure of Rs.654.32 When analyzing the respective elevation averages for the month of March 2022, the High Growns recorded an average of Rs.761.39 which is a positive variance of Rs.130.09 in comparison to Rs.631.30 in March 2021. Medium Growns too recorded a positive variance of Rs.138.77 with an average of Rs.737.88 when compared to Rs.599.11 in March 2021. Similarly, a positive variance of Rs.237.72 was also recorded in the Low Growns with an average of Rs.914.02 in comparison to Rs.676.30 in March 2021.

The 0.73Mkg of Ex-Estate teas on offer met with strong demand. Select best Western High Grown BOPs were dearer, the below best and plainer varieties too followed a similar trend. Select best Western High Grown BOPFs gained from last week's levels, the below best and plainer varieties too were dearer. Nuwara Eliya BOPs were substantially dearer, the BOPFs were irregularly dearer following quality. Udapusellawa BOPs were irregular, the BOPFs were dearer from last week's levels. Uva BOPs / BOPFs gained. Low Grown CTC BP1s were firm to easier at times, the High and Medium sorts were mostly easier. Low Grown CTC PF1s were irregularly dearer and declined as the sale progressed, the High and Medium sorts were irregularly easier.

The 2.3Mkg of Low Grown teas which were on offer continued to attract good demand. In the Leafy segment, select best OPs were dearer whilst the others met with improved demand. Well-made OPAs witnessed improved levels whilst the others were dearer. Better OP1s met with excellent demand, others too appreciated from last week. In the Semi Leafy segment, BOP1s met with improved interest. Pekoe varieties were lower to last. Pekoe1s met with fair demand. In the Small Leaf segment, well-made FBOPs met with improved demand, others were firm on last levels. Well-made FBOPF1s were firm, others were irregular. BOPF.SP, BOPF and BOP.SPs met with fair demand whilst BOPs too followed a similar trend. Select best range in the Premium Flowery segment tended lower, others were mostly firm.

Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent excellent support whilst improved interest was witnessed from Turkey. Libya and Iraq were active.

Western Teas

Select best BOPs were tending irregular, the below best and plainer varieties gained by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-. Select best BOPFs gained by Rs.100/- to Rs.150/-, below best and plainer varieties too followed a similar trend. Medium BOPs gained by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, the BOPFs gained by Rs.80/- to Rs.100/-.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOPs were irregularly dearer following quality, some invoices gained substantially, the BOPFs too followed a similar trend.

Uva Teas

BOPs gained by Rs.50/- to Rs.70/-, the BOPFs too were dearer by Rs.100/- to Rs.150/-. Udapussellawa BOPs were irregularly dearer, the BOPFs too gained by Rs.100/- to Rs.150/-.

CTC Teas

Low Grown BP1s were firm to a little easier at times, the High and Medium sorts were irregularly easier. Low Grown PF1s gained selectively, however declined as the sale progressed, the High and Medium sorts too were firm to a little easier at times.

Low Grown

Select best OP1s were firm, other wiry OP1s along with the bolder invoices gained by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, secondaries too sold at appreciated levels. Well made BOP1s were firm to dearer, bolder types too met with fair demand. Better twisted OPs along with the secondaries gained by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-. Select best OPAs gained by Rs.50/-, best and below best types met with improved demand. Well made Pekoes declined by Rs.30/- to Rs.50/-, bolder types too shed by a similar margin. Shotty Pekoe1s along with the secondary types gained by Rs.50/- and more at times.

Select best and best BOPs were firm on last week's closing levels, below best and secondary types were irregularly lower by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with fair demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best well-made FBOPF1s were dearer by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, Best and below best types were marginally lower to last by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, secondaries were firm. Well-made FBOPs in the select best were firm on last, best types were lower by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, others were firm. FBOPF varieties met with good demand. Select best Premium Flowery teas were lower to last by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, others were irregularly lower.

Off Grades

Select best FGS1s were selectively dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, best and below best types were firm to easier by Rs.10/-, poorer types were easier by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. All BMs declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. Select best and best BPs were firm, below best and poorer types showed a similar trend. Select best BOP1As were firm, others declined irregularly.

Dust

Select best and best Dust1s appreciated by Rs.20/- to Rs.25/-, below best types were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.15/-, poorer sorts were firm to dearer by Rs.10/-. High & Medium CTCs appreciated by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Low Grown CTCs met with fair demand. Low Grown Dust / Dust1s were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.50/- and more at times as the sale progressed.
