COMMENTS



Sri Lanka Tea Exports for the month of March 2022 was recorded at 23.1Mkg which is a decline of 10.2% when compared with the same period of the previous year. The average unit FOB value per kg. was Rs.94.33 above the average unit value per kg of 2021. The cumulative Export quantity for the year recorded a negative variance of 6.1Mkg against the corresponding period. The average FOB value recorded an increase of Rs.49.18 against last year's average FOB price. As a result, the value of Tea Exports for the period (Jan- Mar) in 2022 recorded a negative variance of Rs.2.6 billion over the previous year. Iraq has emerged as the leading Importer of Sri Lanka Tea. The other major Importers were U.A.E, Russia, Azerbaijain and Iran.

The 0.71Mkg of Ex estate teas on offer met with excellent demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs gained, the below best and plainer varieties too followed a similar trend. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs gained substantially and improved as the sale progressed, the below best and plainer varieties followed a similar trend. Nuwara Eliya BOPs were dearer following quality and special inquiry, the BOPFs gained irregularly. Udapusellawa BOPs/ BOPFs appreciated from last levels. The Uva BOPs were dearer with the corresponding BOPFs gaining substantially. Low Grown CTC BP1s were dearer, the High and Medium sorts too were irregularly dearer. Low Grown CTC PF1s too appreciated. The High and Medium sorts followed a similar trend.

The 2.1Mkg of Low Grown teas which were on offer continued to attract good demand. In the Leafy segment, select best OPs were substantially dearer whilst the others met with improved demand. Well-made OPAs met with excellent demand whilst the others were dearer. Better OP1s witnessed improved levels, others too appreciated from last sale. In the Semi Leafy segment, BOP1s met with improved interest. Pekoe varieties were dearer to last levels. Pekoe1 met with good demand. In the Small Leaf segment, all FBOPs met with improved demand, FBOPFs were firm to dearer. Well-made FBOPF1s improved substantially. BOPF.SP, BOPF and BOP.SP met with good demand whilst BOP followed a similar trend. Select best range in the Premium Flowery segment showed improved demand, others too were firm to dearer.

Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent excellent support whilst improved interest was witnessed from Turkey. Libya and Iraq were active.

Western Teas

Select best BOPs gained Rs.200/- to Rs.300/-, the below best and plainer varieties too appreciated by a similar margin. Select best BOPFs gained Rs.100/- to Rs.200/- at the commencement of the sale which improved further as the sale progressed appreciating 200/- to Rs.300/- on average, the below best and plainer sorts too followed a similar trend. Medium BOPs gained substantially, the BOPFs too advanced Rs.200/- to Rs.300/-.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOPs sold well and appreciated selectively following special inquiry, however the BOPFs were irregular and did not show much change from last week's levels.

Uva Teas

BOPs were dearer by Rs.150/- to Rs.200/-, the BOPFs advanced by Rs.200/- to Rs.300/-. Udapussellawa BOPs and BOPFs followed a similar trend.

CTC Teas

Low Grown BP1s gained irregularly, the PF1s appreciated by Rs.300/- to Rs.350/-. The limited selection of High and Medium BP1s were irregular, however the PF1s gained Rs.200/- to Rs.300/-.

Well-made OPs along with the secondaries met with exceptional demand and gained by Rs.100/- on most occasions. All OPAs gained by Rs.80/- to Rs.100/- and more at times. Better twisted BOP1s along with the bolder types gained by Rs.100/-. Select best and best Pekoes were dearer by Rs.80/- to Rs.100/-. Shotty Pekoe1s along with the clean reducers sold at attractive levels, prices increased by Rs.100/- and more at times.

Select best and best BOPs were dearer by Rs.30/- to Rs.40/-, below best and secondary types were firm. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with good demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best well-made FBOPF1s were dearer by Rs.50/- to Rs.60/-, best and below best types too were dearer by Rs.30/- to Rs.40/-, secondaries were firm to dearer by a few rupees. Well-made FBOPs in the select best category were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.50/-, best types too were dearer by Rs.30/- to Rs.40/-, others were firm. FBOPF varieties met with very good demand. All Premium Flowery teas met with improved demand.

Off Grades

Select best and best FGS1s were dearer by Rs.90/- to Rs.120/-, below best and poorer types showed a similar trend. All BMs were dearer by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/-. All BPs were dearer by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/-. Select best BOP1As were firm to dearer by Rs.50/-, others were irregular.

Crop intakes are moderate.

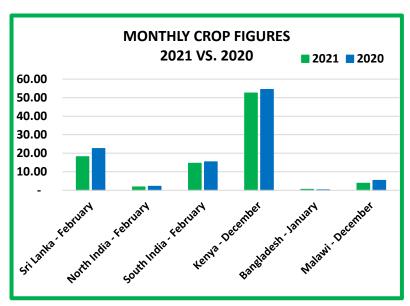


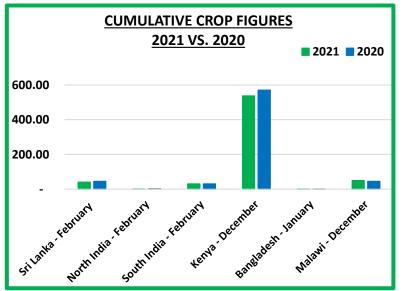
