The Auction averages for the month of April 2024 recorded at Rs.1,216.85 is a decline of Rs.34.93 in comparison to April 2023 which was at Rs.1,251.78. When analyzing the respective elevations, the High Growns recorded an average of Rs.1,157.50 which is a negative variance of Rs.84.70 in comparison to Rs.1,242.20 in April last year. The Medium Growns too recorded a negative variance of Rs.1,067.92 when compared to Rs.1,085.16 in April 2023. Similarly, the Low Growns recorded a negative variance of Rs.3.94 with an average of Rs.1,295.49 in comparison to Rs.1,299.43 in April last year.

The 0.75Mkg of Ex-Estate teas on offer met with fair demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs were firm to easier following quality, the below best and plainer varieties were irregularly easier, however the cleaner and more coloury invoices appreciated. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs mostly declined following quality, the below best types were firm to irregular. Nuwara Eliya BOPs / BOPFs were irregular but mostly easier. Uda Pussellawa BOPs / BOPFs maintained last levels. UVA BOPs / BOPFs were easier. Low Grown CTC BP1s were irregularly easier, the High and Medium sorts were barely steady. Low Grown CTC PF1s were marginally easier, the High and Medium sorts were barely steady.

The 1.8Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with good demand. In the Leafy segment, OPAs were firm, OPs met with irregular demand. OP1s were mostly firm. BOP1s met with fair demand. PEKOEs were firm to dearer, PEKOE1s were firm. In the Small Leaf segment FBOPs met with good demand. Well-made FF1s were firm, others were irregularly lower. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOP grades were firm. FF varieties gained following quality. Premium flowery teas were firm.

Turkey, Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.





## MARKET DESCRIPTION

#### Western Teas

Select best Western High Grown BOPs were firm to Rs.20/- to Rs.50/easier, the below best and plainer sorts too were irregularly lower. Clean leaf coloury sorts appreciated Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- at times. Select best Western High Grown BOPFs declined by Rs.50/- and more following quality, the below best and plainer varieties were tending irregular. Medium BOPs were firm to a little dearer at times, the BOPFs gained marginally and were tending irregular.

#### Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOP / BOPFs were irregular but, mostly easier.

#### Uva Teas

Uva BOPs declined by Rs.50/- on average, the BOPFs too were tending easier by Rs.20/- to Rs.50/-. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were firm, the BOPFs maintained on last levels.

#### **CTC** Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s were irregularly easier, the High and Medium sorts were barely steady. Low Grown CTC PF1s were Rs.20/- to Rs.30/- easier, the High and Medium sorts were firm to a little irregular.

## **MARKET DESCRIPTION**



#### Low Grown

Select best OP1s maintained last levels, other good OP1s improved irregularly, secondaries too met with fair demand. Better twisted OPs along with the other well-made invoices met with good demand, semi leafy invoices continued a downward trend from last week. Well-made OPAs were firm to dearer, below best types too were firm on last levels. In the Semi Leafy segment, wiry BOP1s were lower by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, bolder types were firm to dearer. Select best Pekoes were dearer by Rs.50/-, bold Pekoes were dearer by Rs.100/- to Rs.150/-, others met with fair demand. Select best were firm on last levels, others met with irregular demand.

Select best and best BOPs were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, below best and secondary types were firm. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with good demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best and best FBOPF1s were fully firm, below best types were irregularly lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, secondary types were firm. Select best and best FBOPs were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/- and more following quality, below best types were firm, secondary types too were firm. FF varieties were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-. All Premium Flowery teas met with good demand.

#### **Off Grades**


Select best and best Fgs1s were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/- whilst below best and poorer sorts appreciated by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. Select best and best BMs were firm to dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, below best and poorer types were firm on last levels. Select best and best BPs maintained on last levels below best and poorer varieties were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Select best BOP1As were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, best types maintained on last levels, below best types were lower by Rs.50/- to Rs.70/- whilst poorer sorts were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-.

#### Dust

Select best and best Dust1s declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, below best and poorer types were firm. High and Medium CTCs were easier by Rs.20/-. Low Grown CTCs showed an irregular demand. Low Grown Dust / Dust1s were firm.

Galle, Rathnapura and Deniyaya recorded bright weather with evening showers throughout the week.






