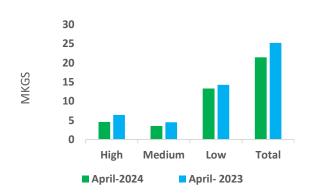

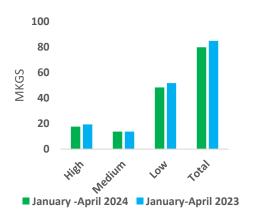


Sri Lanka harvested a crop of 21.4Mkg during the Month of April 2024, which is a decline of 15% when compared to the crop harvested in April 2023.

The main contributor for the 21.4Mkg was from the Low Grown planting districts with 62.1%, followed by High Growns at 21.4% and the Medium Growns at 16.6%. When compared with the crop in April 2024, negative variances were recorded in the High Growns at 28.6%, Medium Growns at 21.3% followed by the Low Growns at 6.8%.

COMMENTS – Cont;



Sri Lanka Tea Exports for the month of April 2024 was recorded at 16.3Mkg which is an increase of 1.2% when compared with the same period of the previous year. The average unit FOB value per kg. was Rs.111.17 below the average unit value per kg of April 2023. The cumulative Export quantity for the year recorded a positive variance of 8.4Mkg against the corresponding period. The cumulative average FOB value recorded a decline of Rs.223.93 against last year's average FOB price. As a result, the value of Tea Exports for the period (January- April) in 2024 recorded a negative variance of Rs.749 million over the previous year. Iraq emerged as the leading importer of Sri Lanka Tea and the other major importers were U.A.E, Russia, Turkey and Iran.

The 0.90Mkg of Ex-Estate teas on offer met with irregular demand at easier levels. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs barely maintained, the below best and plainer varieties declined following quality. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs were tending lower, the below best and plainer varieties followed a similar trend, however to a lesser extent. Nuwara Eliya BOPs were tending irregular, the BOPFs were firm. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were easier, the BOPFs too commenced lower and declined further as the sale progressed. UVA BOPs were firm, the BOPFs were firm to easier at times. Low Grown CTC BP1s were firm to irregular, the High and Medium sorts too barely maintained last levels. Low Grown CTC PF1s declined sharply from last levels, the High and Medium sorts were barely steady and mostly easier.

The 2.9Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with good demand. In the Leafy segment, OP/OPAs were low. OP1s declined sharply. BOP1s were irregularly lower. PEKOEs were firm, PEKOE1s met with less demand. In the Small Leaf segment well-made FBOPs were firm, others were lower. FBOPF1s were lower to last. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOP grades were firm. FBOPF varieties were firm. Premium Flowery teas gained following quality.

Turkey, Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.





MARKET DESCRIPTION

Western Teas

Select best Western High Grown BOPs were barely steady, the below best and plainer varieties declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-. Select best Western High Grown BOPFs declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- and more, the below best and plainer varieties too were easier by Rs.20/- to Rs.50/-. Medium BOPs declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/-, the BOPFs too were easier by Rs.50/- on average.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOPs were tending irregular, the BOPFs were firm.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs were firm, the BOPFs were easier by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/- on average. Uda Pussellawa BOPs eased by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/-, the BOPFs were easier by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/- and declined further as the sale progressed.

CTC Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s were firm to a little irregular at times, the High and Medium sorts too barely maintained last levels. Low Grown CTC PF1s declined by Rs.100/- and more, the High and Medium sorts were irregularly easier.

MARKET DESCRIPTION



Low Grown

Select best OP1s were firm on last levels, other wiry OP1s met with declining demand, below best sorts maintained last week's closing levels. Better twisted OPs were firm, below best types were irregular. Select best OPAs along with the best types declined slightly and more towards the end of the sale, others too were firm to marginally easier. Select best BOP1s were lower to last, bolder types were firm on last levels. Select best Pekoes showed a sharp decline, bolder types were easier by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Shotty Pekoe1s too showed a sharp decline, secondaries were lower to last.

Select best BOPs were firm, best and below best types were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, secondary types were firm. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with reasonable demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best FBOPF1s were firm, best and below best types were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-, secondary types were lower to last. Select best and best FBOPs were firm, below best types were lower by a few rupees, secondary types were firm. FBOPF varieties were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-. All Premium Flowery teas met with good demand.

Off Grades

Select best and best Fgs1s maintained on last levels whilst, below best and poorer sorts appreciated by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. Select best and best BMs were firm on last levels, below best and poorer types were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.30/. Select best and best BPs maintained on last levels, below best and poorer varieties were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Select best BOP1As maintained on last levels, best types were higher by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, below best types were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, whilst poorer sorts were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-.

Dust

Select best and best Dust1s declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/- and more, below best and poorer types declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. High and Medium CTCs declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Low Grown CTCs declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.70/-. Low Grown Dust / Dust1s declined by Rs.50/-.
