COMMENTS



The 0.82Mkg of Ex-Estate teas on offer met with improved demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs appreciated following quality, the below best and plainer sorts were firm to dearer. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs gained selectively following quality, the below best and plainer varieties too were dearer to a lesser extent. Nuwara Eliya BOPs / BOPFs mostly remained unsold due to a lack of suitable bids. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were barely steady, the BOPFs were irregular following quality. Uva BOPs were tending irregular, the BOPF barely maintained. Low Grown CTC BP1s were tending easier, the High and Medium sorts too were irregular. Low Grown CTC PF1s were firm to marginally dearer at times, the High and Medium sorts were firm on last levels.

The 2.2Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with good demand. In the Leafy segment, Select Best OP/OPA's were lower, others appreciated following quality. OP1s witnessed good demand. BOP1s were firm. PEKOEs met with improved demand, PEKOE1s too followed a similar trend. In the Small Leaf segment all FBOPs met with improved demand. FF1s experienced strong demand. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOP grades were firm. FF varieties were selectively dearer. Premium flowery teas met with good demand.

Turkey, Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.





MARKET DESCRIPTION

Western Teas

Select best Western High Grown BOPs appreciated Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- and more following quality, the below best and plainer varieties were firm to Rs.30/- to Rs.50/- dearer. Select best Western High Grown BOPFs gained Rs.30/- to Rs.60/- and more following quality, the below best and plainer varieties too gained Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- on average. Medium BOP / BOPFs were firm.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOP / BOPFs mostly remained unsold due to lacks of suitable bids.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs were tending irregular, the BOPFs barely maintained last levels. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were barely steady, the BOPFs too were irregular following quality.

CTC Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s were tending easier, the High and Medium sorts were irregular. Low Grown CTC PF1s were firm to marginally dearer at times, the High and Medium sorts were firm on last levels.

Low Grown

Select best OP1s were firm to irregularly dearer, bolder types along with the below best invoices gained from last levels. Better twisted OPs were firm to easier, below best sorts however met with fair demand. Select best OPAs declined sharply, below best sorts were firm on last levels. Select best BOP1s experienced a sharp decline, bolder types were lower by Rs.50/-. Select best Pekoes and bolder types were dearer. Shotty Pekoe1s were firm on last levels, secondaries met with fair demand.

Select best and best BOPs were dearer by Rs. 20/- to Rs. 40/-, below best and secondary types were firm. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with fair demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best and best FBOPF1s were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-, below best and secondary types were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/- and more at times. Select best and best FBOPs were firm, below best and secondary types were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-. FF varieties were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-. All Premium Flowery teas met with good demand.

Off Grades

Select best and best Fgs1s were firm on last levels whilst, below best and poorer sorts were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. Select best and best BMs were firm on last levels, below best and poorer types were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/. Select best and best BPs depreciated by Rs.40/- to Rs.80/-, below best and poorer varieties maintained on last levels. Select best BOP1As were higher by Rs.50/- to Rs.70/-, best types were higher by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, below best BOP1As were higher by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, whilst poorer sorts maintained on last levels.

Dust

Select best and best Dust1s were firm to dearer by Rs.20/-, below best and poorer types were firm. High and Medium CTCs showed an irregular demand. Low Grown CTCs declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Low Grown Dust / Dust1s were firm.

Crop intakes are low.






MOMBASA MARKET

SALE NO. 24 - SALE OF 10TH / 11TH JUNE 2024

There was fairly good general demand for the 276,659 packages (18,556,820.50 kilos) available with 45.99% unsold.

MARKETS

Egyptian Packers lent more support with maintained enquiry from Pakistan Packers, Bazaar and Afghanistan. Kazakhstan, other CIS states and UK saw more but selective interest while Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries reduced activity. Sudan and South Sudan were more active with some interest from Russia. Local Packers showed improved support while Iran were quiet. Somalia continued active at the lower end of the market.

OFFERINGS

 157,080 packages (10,363,336.50 kilos) – 50.93% unsold.

 Dust Grades
 89,640 packages (6,693,704.00 kilos) – 44.09% unsold.

 Secondary Grades
 29,939 packages (1,499,780.00 kilos) – 25.79% unsold.

LEAF GRADES (M2)

BP1:

Best – Were firm to USC36 dearer with select lines advancing by USC57 and USC78, some lines however eased by up to USC4.

Brighter – Mostly steady with select invoices appreciating by USC9 and USC21.

Mediums – KTDA mediums saw a few lines absorbed at reserve prices while the majority remained unsold. Plantation mediums met improved competition and gained up to USC40 with select invoices dearer by USC86.

Lower Medium – Ranged between firm to USC16 above last prices with select improved invoices gaining USC43 and USC60 to easier by up to USC21.

Plainer – Varied between USC20 dearer to easier by USC12.

PF1:

Best – Met improved competition and appreciated by up to USC29, a few lines however lost up to USC18.

Brighter - Firm to USC13 dearer.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were steady at previous levels while plantation mediums were irregular varying between firm to USC8 dearer to easier by up to USC26.

Lower Medium – Saw some lines gaining up to USC8 while others lost up to USC14.

Plainer – Irregular with some teas advancing by up to USC20 while others lost up to USC9.

DUST GRADES (M1)

PDUST:

Best – Were firm to USC34 above previous levels to easier by up to USC7.

Brighter – Steady at last levels.

Mediums – KTDA mediums held value while plantation mediums appreciated by up to USC14.

Lower Medium – Ranged between firm to USC18 dearer to easier by up to USC5.

Plainer – Were irregular varying between steady to USC14 dearer to easier by a similar margin.





MOMBASA MARKET – Continued;

DUST1:

Best – Ranged between USC12 dearer to easier by up to USC6.

Brighter – Were firm to USC12 above last prices.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were steady at previous levels while plantation mediums lost up to USC8 with a few invoices discounted by USC34 and USC54.

Lower Medium – Were irregular and varied between firm to dearer by up to USC6 to easier by up to USC3.

Plainer – Saw some teas advance by up to USC8 while others shed up to USC10.

SECONDARY GRADES (S1)

In the Secondary Catalogues, BPs held value with PFs firm. Clean well sorted coloury Fannings were steady while similar DUSTs were dearer. Other Fannings were firm with DUSTs selling at last levels. BMFs were readily absorbed.

CHITTAGONG MARKET

SALE NO. 07 - 10TH JUNE 2024

CTC LEAF: 21,107 packages of tea on offer once again met with a good demand.

BROKENS: Well made good liquoring Brokens were a strong feature and were fully firm on last. Their Medium varieties met with a good demand and were mostly dearer following competition. Plainer types met with an improved market and prices were slightly dearer. BLF teas met with a fair demand at around last levels. .

FANNINGS: Well made good liquoring Fannings were a good market and sold at around last levels whilst their Mediums were a dearer market following competition. Plain and BLF teas continued to meet with fair demand with some withdrawals.

DUST: 7,161 packages of tea on offer met with good demand. Good liquoring Dusts sold well with Tk.5/- to Tk. 8/- higher than last levels. Medium Dusts had fair demand and sold in line with quality. Plain/BLF Dusts had fair demand with fewer withdrawals than last. Blenders lent good support whilst Loose tea buyers were fairly active.

COMMENTS: There was more widespread demand in this sale and both Blenders and Internal buyers lent good support. All good liquoring Invoices once again met with good competition and prices remained fully firm.

Dusts sold well.


