The 0.69Mkg of Ex-Estate teas on offer met with irregular demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs were irregular and gained marginally following quality, the below best and plainer sorts were firm on last levels. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs appreciated selectively following special inquiry, the below best and plainer varieties were firm to irregular at times. Nuwara Eliya BOPs / BOPFs mostly remained unsold due to a lack of suitable bids. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were firm on last levels, the BOPFs were barely steady. Uva BOPs were mostly easier, the BOPFs were barely steady. Low Grown CTC BP1s were marginally easier, the High and Medium sorts were irregular. Low Grown CTC PF1s were firm to marginally dearer, the High and Medium sorts were firm to irregularly easier.

The 2.2Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with good demand. In the Leafy segment, OP/OPA's met with lower demand, OP1s met with irregular demand, BOP1s were firm. PEKOEs met with improved demand, select best well-made PEKOE1s were firm, others met with irregular demand. In the Small Leaf segment, all FBOPs met with good demand. FF1s experienced strong demand. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOP grades were firm. FF varieties were selectively dearer. Premium flowery teas met with good demand.

Turkey, Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.





Western Teas

Select best Western High Grown BOPs were irregular and gained Rs.50/- at times, below best and plainer varieties were firmto a little irregular following quality. Select best Western High Grown BOPFs gained Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- selectively, the below best and plainer varieties were firm to a little irregular at times. Medium BOPs were firm to a little dearer, the BOPFs followed a similar trend.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOP / BOPFs mostly remained unsold due to lacks of suitable bids.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs were easier by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/- at times, the BOPFs were barely steady. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were firm on last levels, the BOPFs were barely steady.

CTC Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s were marginally easier, the High and Medium sorts were irregular. Low Grown CTC PF1s were firm to Rs.20/- dearer, the High and Medium sorts were firm to irregularly easier.

MARKET DESCRIPTION



Low Grown

Select best OP1s were firm, however at lower levels, best types were slightly easier, below best types improved from last week. All OPs met with lower demand. Select best OPAs with the exception of few invoices tended lower, secondaries met with reasonable demand. Select best BOP1s were firm on last levels, bolder types were firm to dearer by Rs.50/-. Select best Pekoes were firm to dearer, bolder types were dearer by Rs.50/-. Shotty Pekoe1s were firm on last levels, others met with fair demand.

Select best and best BOPs were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, below best and secondary types were firm. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with fair demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best and best FBOPF1s were fully firm, below best and secondary types were irregularly lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/- and more at times. Select best and best FBOPs were firm, below best and secondary types were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-. FF varieties were firm. All Premium Flowery teas met with good demand.

Off Grades

Select best and best Fgs1s were firm on last levels whilst, below best and poorer sorts depreciated by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/- towards the latter part. Select best and best BMs maintained on last levels, below best and poorer types were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/. Select best and best BPs were firm on last levels, below best and poorer varieties depreciated by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Select best BOP1As were higher by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, best types were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-, below best types were higher by Rs.30/- to Rs.40/-.

Dust

Select best DUST1s declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/-, best and below best types declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, poor DUST1s were firm. High & Medium CTCs declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Low Grown CTCs declined by Rs.30/- to Rs.50/- and more towards the closure. Low Grown DUST / Dust1s were firm.

Rainfall was recorded throughout the week in Galle, Rathnapura and Deniyaya districts.



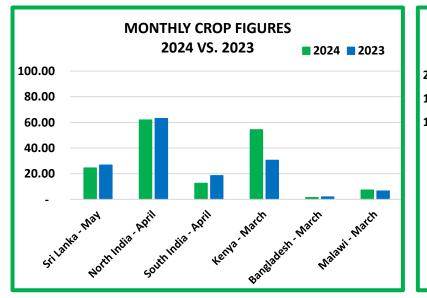

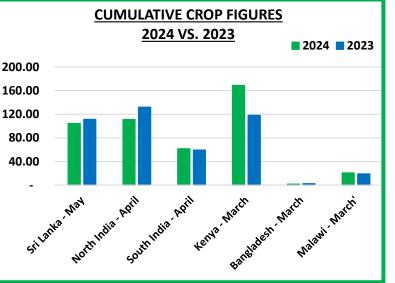

Fairly good demand for the 285,380 packages (19,173,854.00 kilos) available in the market with 52.32% remaining unsold.

MARKETS

Pakistan Packers lent strong support but at lower levels while Egyptian Packers, Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries maintained enquiry. Bazaar, Afghanistan and UK showed improved interest with reduced activity from Sudan, South Sudan, Kazakhstan and other CIS states. Russia and Local Packers showed some activity while Iran were quiet. Somalia were active at the lower end of the market.

LEAF GRADES (M2)

BP1:

Best - Were firm to irregularly easier by up to USC86.

Brighter – Irregular varying between steady to USC10 dearer to easier by a similar margin.

Mediums – KTDA mediums saw a few lines selling at last levels with most teas neglected. Plantation mediums were firm with some invoices advancing by up to USC23 and a few lines lost USC38.

Lower Medium – Were irregular ranging between firm /to USC17 dearer to easier by up to USC16. **Plainer** – Met reduced competition and shed up to USC35.

<u> PF1:</u>

Best – Saw some teas advance by up to USC8 while a number of lines eased by up to USC9 and select invoices were discounted by USC27.

Brighter – Ranged between firm to USC17 dearer to easier by up to USC16.

Mediums – KTDA mediums held value with a few lines irregular varying between dearer by up to USC4 to easier by a similar margin. Plantation mediums were firm to USC7 dearer with selected invoices appreciating by USC17.

Lower Medium – Were irregular ranging between steady to USC17 above previous levels and select invoices gained USC30 to easier by up to USC13. Plainer – Irregular with some teas advancing by up to USC14 while others lost up to USC18.

DUST GRADES (M1)

PDUST:

Best – Were firm to USC12 dearer to easier by up to USC35.

Brighter - Steady at previous levels.

Mediums – KTDA mediums varied between firm to USC2 dearer to easier by up to USC4 with a number of invoices remaining unsold while plantation mediums saw some teas appreciating by up to USC12 with select lines advancing by USC30 to easier by up to USC7.

Lower Medium - Firm to easier by up to USC18.

Plainer – Shed up to USC23 with a few teas discounted by USC42.



MOMBASA MARKET – Continued ;

DUST1:

Best – Ranged between steady to USC13 dearer with selected invoices gaining USC71 to easier by USC27.

Brighter – Firm for most teas while some lines varied between USC4 dearer to USC8 easier.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were mainly steady with a few teas irregular varying between USC7 dearer to USC9 below previous prices and a number of invoices were neglected. Plantation mediums eased by up to USC10, a few invoices however advanced by USC14.

Lower Medium – Irregular at firm to USC16 dearer to easier by up to USC15.

Plainer – Ranged between USC18 dearer to easier by up to USC10.

SECONDARY GRADES (S1)

In the Secondary Catalogues, **BPs** were dearer with **PFs** about steady. Clean well sorted coloury **Fannings** tended dearer while **similar DUSTs** were firm. **Other Fannings** held value with **DUSTs** steady. **BMFs** were readily absorbed.
