COMMENTS



The Auction averages for the month of June 2023 recorded at Rs.974.36, is a decline of Rs.270.86 in comparison to June 2022 which was at Rs.1,245.22. When analyzing the respective elevations, the High Growns recorded an average of Rs.848.57 which is a negative variance of Rs.163.50 in comparison to Rs.1,012.07 in June last year. The Medium Growns too recorded a negative variance of Rs.136.27 with an average of Rs.856.12 when compared to Rs.992.39 in June 2022. Similarly, the Low Growns recorded a negative variance of Rs.362.63 with an average of Rs.1,067.85 in comparison to Rs.1,430.48 in June last year.

The 1Mkg of Ex-Estate teas on offer met with fair demand at irregular levels. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs barely maintained last levels, the below best and plainer sorts declined. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs were firm to easier, the below best and plainer sorts appreciated marginally. Nuwara Eliya BOP/BOPFs mostly remained unsold. Uda Pussellawa BOPs declined from last levels, the well-made BOPFs declined sharply whilst the others barely maintained last levels. Uva BOPs appreciated selectively, the others declined, the BOPFs were tending easier from last levels. Low grown CTC BP1s were firm, the High and Medium sorts were firm to irregular. Low Grown CTC PF1s maintained last levels whilst the High and medium sorts were barely steady and declined irregularly.

The 2.9Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with fair demand. In the Leafy segment, OP/OPA's were irregularly lower. OP1s were lower to last. BOP1s met with fair demand. Well-made PEKs were lower to last, PEK1s too declined as the sale progressed. In the Small Leaf segment, FBOPs were firm to dearer. Well-made FF1s appreciated following quality, others met with improved interest. FF varieties were firm. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOPSP and BOP grades met with fair interest. Premium flowery teas were firm.

Turkey, Russia and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Iran continued to be selective. Libya and Iraq were active.





MARKET DESCRIPTION

Western Teas

Select best BOPs were firm to irregularly easier, below best and plainer sorts declined by Rs.40/- to Rs.50/-. Select best BOPFs were firm to Rs.50/- easier, the below best and plainer sorts appreciated selectively by Rs.30/- to Rs.50/-. However better demand prevailed for the more coloury sorts. Medium BOPs were firm to a little dearer, the BOPFs too gained Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOP / BOPFs mostly remained unsold.

Uva Teas

A few coloury Uva BOPs appreciated Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, the BOPFs however declined by a similar margin. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were easier, the better made BOPFs declined sharply, whilst the others maintained last levels.

CTC Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s were barely steady, whilst the High and Medium sorts were firm. Low Grown CTC PF1s were firm on last levels, the Medium Grown types were tending dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.50/-, whilst the High Grown types barely maintained last levels and were irregularly easier at times.

MARKET DESCRIPTION



Low Grown

Select best OP1s sold with lesser demand to last week, other wiry OP1s too tended lower, bolder OP1s eased by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, secondaries maintained last levels. Well-made OPs met with reasonable demand, others were irregular. OPAs in the select best and best categories eased by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- and more as the sale progressed, secondaries met with fair demand. In the Semi Leafy segment, well twisted BOP1s were firm to marginally easier, bolder types however sold at last levels. Well-made Pekoes along with the heavy bold Pekoe invoices were firm to marginally easier, secondaries however were firm on last levels. Shotty Pekoe1s were firm to irregularly dearer, reducers too met with fair demand.

Select best and best BOPs were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, below best and secondary types too were dearer by Rs.30/- to Rs.40/- and more following quality. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with improved demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Well-made select best and best FBOPF1s were dearer by Rs.30/- to Rs.40/- and more at times, below best types were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/- and more following quality, secondary types were firm. Well-made FBOPs in the select best category were firm, best and below best types were firm to lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, secondary types were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. FBOPF varieties met with lower demand. All Premium Flowery teas were firm.

Off Grades

Select best and best Fgs1s declined by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/- and more at times as the sale progressed, below best and poorer sorts declined by Rs.30/- to Rs.40/-. Select best and best BMs were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- and more at times , below best and poorer types maintained on last levels. Select best and best BPs appreciated by Rs.10/- to Rs.30/- and more at times as the sale progressed, below best and poorer types showed an irregular demand. Select best and best BOP1As maintained on last levels, below best types were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, whilst poorer sorts were also lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.30/-.

Dust

Select best and best Dust1s were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/- and more towards the closure, below best and poorer types were easier by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Select best and best High and Medium CTCs were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, below best and poorer types declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Low Grown CTCs were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-. Low Grown Dust/ Dust1s were firm.

CropCrop intake in the Western, Nuwara Eliya and Uva/Uda Pussellawa regions are low whilst, there was an increase in crops in the Low grown region.





