# **COMMENTS**



Sri Lanka Tea Exports for the month of June 2022 was recorded at 23.5Mkg which is a decline of 12.6% when compared with the same period of the previous year. The average unit FOB value per kg. was Rs.862.38 above the average unit value per kg of 2021. The cumulative Export quantity for the year recorded a negative variance of 11.6Mkg against the corresponding period. The cumulative average FOB value recorded an increase of Rs.377.56 against last year's average FOB price. As a result, the value of Tea Exports for the period (January- June) in 2022 recorded a positive variance of Rs.36.4 billion over the previous year. Iraq has emerged as the leading importer of Sri Lanka Tea. The other major importers were U.A.E, Russia Turkey and Azerbaijain.

The 0.57Mkg of Ex estate teas on offer met with good demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs gained, whilst the below best and plainer varieties too appreciated from last week's levels. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs were dearer, the below best and plainer sorts too, followed a similar trend. Nuwara Eliya BOPs were easier, the BOPFs were barely steady. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were irregularly lower, the BOPF were selectively dearer. UVA BOPs were easier, however the BOPFs were mostly dearer. Low Grown CTC BP1s gained, the High and Medium sorts were irregular. The Low Grown CTC PF1s too appreciated, the High and Medium sorts too were irregularly dearer.

The 2.3Mkg of Low Grown teas which were on offer met with good demand. In the Leafy segment, OPs were firm. Better OPAs were dearer, others were firm. OP1s met with good demand. In the Semi Leafy segment, BOP1s were irregularly lower. Pekoe varieties were lower, Pekoe1s were irregular. In the Small Leaf segment, well-made FBOPs were lower, others met with fair demand. FBOPF varieties were firm. Better FBOPF1s were a few rupees lower, others met with good demand. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOPs sold at fair levels. All Premium Flowery teas sold at firm levels.

Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent fair support, Turkey was selective. Libya and Iraq were active.

Medium BOPs were firm to a little dearer, the BOPFs were mostly firm.

## **Nuwara Eliya Teas**

BOPs were tending easier, the BOPFs too were irregularly lower.

## **Uva Teas**

Uva / Uda Pussellawa BOPs were irregularly easier, corresponding BOPFs however gained Rs.30/- to Rs.50/-following quality, others were tending easier.

## **CTC Teas**

## **Low Grown**

Select best OP1s were mainly firm, other well twisted OP1s along with the bolder types gained Rs.50/- to Rs.80/- and more at times, secondaries however met with irregular demand. Select best BOP1s were lower to last, others met with fair demand. Well-made OPs were dearer by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, secondaries were marginally lower. Well-made OPAs met with good demand and were mostly dearer, secondaries however were firm to easier by Rs.30/- to Rs.50/-. Well-made Pekoes met with lower demand, bold Pekoes too were firm to easier, reducers dropped by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/-. Shotty Pekoe1s were mainly firm, below best sorts too met with reasonable demand.

Select best and best BOPs were firm, below best and secondary types were firm to dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with very good demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best and best FBOPFF1s were irregularly lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, below best types met with very fair demand, secondaries were firm. Well-made FBOPs in the select best category were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, best types too were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, others were firm. FBOPF varieties met with good demand. Select best Premium Flowery teas were lower by a few rupees, others were firm on last.

## **Off Grades**

Select best and best FGS1s were dearer by Rs.30/- to Rs.50/-, below best and poorer types were firm. Select best and best BMs were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, below best and poorer types declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. All BPs were firm. Select best and best BOP1As met with good demand, others were irregular.

## **Dust**

Select best and best Dust1s appreciated Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, below best and poorer sorts were dearer by Rs.15/- to Rs.20/-. High and Medium CTCs appreciated by Rs.10/- to Rs.15/-. Low Grown CTCs were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.15/-. Low Grown Dust/Dust1s were irregularly lower by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-.
