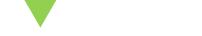

From Global auction centres around the world, it is evident that demand is revolving mostly around quality and is compensated with price. This trend is expected to continue with an oversupply situation around the world. Lower quality teas are discounted and remain unsold.

The Auction averages for the month of July 2024 recorded at Rs.1,223.88 is an increase of Rs.212.44 in comparison to July 2023 which was at Rs.1,011.44. When analyzing the respective elevations, the High Growns recorded an average of Rs.1,153.38 which is a positive variance of Rs.286.02 in comparison to Rs.867.36 in July last year. The Medium Growns too recorded a positive variance of Rs.179.04 with an average of Rs.1,070.42 when compared to Rs.891.38 in July 2023. Similarly, the Low Growns recorded a positive variance of Rs.191.81 with an average of Rs.1,299.84 in comparison to Rs.1,108.03 in July last year.

0.85 million kilograms of Ex-Estate teas on offer met with fair demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs were firm, whilst the below best and plainer varieties were irregularly lower. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs were firm, the below best and plainer sorts were irregularly lower. Nuwara Eliya BOPs / BOPFs mostly remained unsold. Uda Pussellawa BOPs gained marginally, the BOPFs appreciated from previous levels. Uva BOPs were lower, the BOPFs barely maintained last levels. Low Grown BP1s were firm, the High and Medium sorts were dearer. Low Grown CTC PF1s gained, while High and Medium sorts were tending lower.

The 2.3Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with fair demand. In the Leafy segment, OP/OPA's were firm. OP1s met with fair demand. BOP1s were firm. PEKOEs met with good demand, PEKOE1s were firm. In the Small Leaf segment, Well-made FBOPs met with fair demand, others were lower. FF1s experienced lower demand. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOP grades were firm. FF varieties were lower. Premium flowery teas met with lower interest.

Turkey, Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.

Western Teas

Select best Western High Grown BOPs were firm, the below best and plainer varieties were irregularly lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. Select best Western High Grown BOPFs were firm, the below best and plainer varieties were irregularly lower by Rs.30/ to Rs.40/. Medium BOPs were firm, the BOPFs followed a similar trend.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOP/ BOPFs mostly remained unsold.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs depreciated Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, the BOPFs were firm. Uda Pussellawa BOPs gained Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, BOPFs too were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-.

CTC Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s sold at last levels, the High and Medium sorts were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Low Grown CTC PF1s gained Rs.30/- to Rs.40/-, the High and Medium sorts declined by a similar margin.

MARKET DESCRIPTION



Low Grown

Select best and best OP1s met with fair demand, bolder types were firm to dearer, secondaries sold at last levels. Better twisted OPs were firm on last levels, others gained irregularly. Well-made OPAs were firm on last, others too met with fair demand. Well twisted BOP1s were firm on last, bolder types were firm to easier. All Pekoes were firm on last levels. Shotty Pekoe1s were dearer, others met with good demand.

Select best BOPs were firm, best types were lower by a few rupees, below best and secondary types were firm. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with fair demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best and best FBOPF1s were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs. 60/-, below best types were irregularly lower, secondary types were firm. Select best FBOPs were firm, best and below best types were lower by Rs.60/- to Rs.80/- and more at times, secondary types too were lower. FF varieties met with lower demand. All Premium Flowery teas were lower by Rs.60/- to Rs.80/- and more following quality.

Off Grades

Select best Fgs1s were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/- whilst best Fgs1s were firm on last levels, below best and poorer sorts were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Select best and best BMs depreciated by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-, below best and poorer types maintained on last levels. Select best and best BPs were firm on last levels whilst below best and poorer varieties were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Select best BOP1As were higher by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, best types were higher by Rs.60/- to Rs.70/-, below best types were lower by Rs.30/- to Rs.40/- whilst poorer types were lower by Rs.20/-.

Dust

Select best and best Dust1s declined by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-, below best and poorer sorts declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. High and Medium CTCs declined by Rs.40/- to Rs.80/- and more towards the closure. Low Grown CTCs and Dust/ Dust1s were firm.

Bright weather with occasional rainfall was reported throughout the week in Galle, Rathnapura and Deniyaya districts.







The multiple reprint tea auction (M4) saw improved activity for the 68,160 packages (4,613,953.00 kilos) offered with 75.88% remaining unsold.

MARKETS

There was strong support from **Pakistan Packers** while **Egyptian Packers**, **Bazaar** and **Afghanistan** maintained interest. **Yemen** and **other Middle Eastern countries** showed more activity with **UK** active but selective. **Sudan** and **South Sudan** lent more support with some enquiry from **Kazakhstan**, **other CIS states** and **Russia**. **Local Packers** were less active while **Iran** were quiet. **Somalia** were more active at the lower end of the market.

Best - Varied between mostly steady to irregularly easier by up to USC21 to dearer by up to USC25 for a few lines.

Brighter – Were irregular ranging between firm to USC26 dearer to easier by a similar margin.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were steady to USC6 dearer to easier by up to USC4 where sold while plantation mediums saw improved competition and advanced by up to USC24 with select teas dearer by USC37 but a few lines shed up to USC6.

Lower Medium – Irregular varying between firm to USC27 above last levels with select invoices dearer by USC37 to easier by up to USC18 with a few invoices discounted by USC36. Plainer – Ranged between firm to USC9 dearer with improved lines gaining USC32 to easier by USC9.

<u> PF1:</u>

Best – Appreciated by up to USC23.

Brighter – Were steady to dearer by up to USC22.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were firm with a few lines irregular varying between USC14 dearer to easier by up to USC15. Plantation mediums were steady to USC16 dearer and select invoices appreciated by USC42.

Lower Medium – Steady to USC16 above previous levels.

Plainer – Saw some teas advance by up to USC14 while others shed up to USC9.

DUST GRADES (M1)

PDUST:

Best – Met irregular enquiry and ranged between firm to USC25 dearer to easier by up to US11 with select invoices shedding USC32.

Brighter – Were steady to USC15 above last levels.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were mostly firm with a few lines dearer by up to USC4 but select teas lost USC20. Plantation mediums appreciated by up to USC16 but a few invoices eased by a similar margin.

Lower Medium – Saw most teas easier by up to USC16 while others appreciated by up to USC11 and selected invoices gained USC23.

Plainer - Varied between firm to USC24 dearer for most lines to easier by up to USC27.

Best – Steady to USC20 above last rates.

Brighter – Firm to dearer by up to USC7.

Lower Medium – Irregular ranging between firm to USC8 dearer to easier by a similar margin.

CTC LEAF: 55,252 packages of tea on offer met with a fair demand.

BROKENS: Well made good liquoring Brokens once again met with a fairly good demand but were easier. Medium types also met with a fairly good demand again at easier rates. Plainer types met with less demand and prices were easier with more withdrawals. BLFs met with a restricted demand with quite heavy withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Well made good liquoring Fannings were a fairly good market but prices were slightly easier following quality. Medium varieties were also a fairly good market but prices eased slightly. Plainer types met with less demand and prices were easier with more withdrawals. BLFs met with a restricted demand with quite heavy withdrawals.

DUST: 11,234 packages of tea on offer met with a fairly good demand. Good liquoring Dusts sold well at slightly easier rates. Their Mediums were also a lower market and prices declined upto Tk.10/- closely following quality. Plain/BLF Dusts met with less demand and sold barely steady with quite fair withdrawals. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: This sale was held two days later than schedule where offerings were again higher. Blenders lent good support particularly for the good liquoring varieties on offer whilst Loose tea buyers were selective. As a result, withdrawals were more this week. Dusts sold well.


