The Low Grown Orthodox average last week recorded at 1,279.23/-, was the lowest for the year 2024. In USD terms, this average ranks as the second lowest for the year. The decline in prices was attributed to the significant drop in Tippy and small leaf tea prices, influenced by international concerns, particularly from Iran. Additionally, last week's auction recorded the lowest overall average for the Low Grown elevation in 2024 thus far.

The much-anticipated Uva quality seasonal teas met with widespread demand with substantially high prices for the invoices with flavour. With the weather conditions changing on the Uva slopes hindering the manufacture of seasonal teas, the limited volumes on offer are keenly sort after with competitive bidding.

0.83Mkg of Ex-Estate teas on offer met with fair demand. Select Best and best Western High Grown BOPs were dearer, whilst the below best and plainer varieties declined. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs were dearer, with the below-best maintaining and plainer sorts easing. Nuwara Eliya BOPs and BOPFs mostly remained unsold. Uda Pussellawa BOPs sold at firm levels, BOPFs appreciated. Uva seasonal BOP/BOPFs met with excellent demand, whilst the others too were dearer to a lesser extent. Low grown BP1s were firm, the high and medium sorts were dearer. Low Grown CTC PF1s gained, while the High and Medium sorts were firm to dearer.

The 2.3Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with fair demand. In the Leafy segment, OP/OPA's were lower. OP1s met with fair demand. BOP1s were selectively lower. PEKOEs met with good demand, PEKOE1s were firm. In the Small Leaf segment, Well-made FBOPs met with fair demand, others were lower. FF1s experienced lower demand. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOP grades were firm. FF varieties were lower. Premium flowery teas met with improved demand.

Turkey, Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.





MARKET DESCRIPTION

Western Teas

Select best Western High Grown BOPs gained Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, the below best and plainer varieties were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. Select best Western High Grown BOPFs were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, the below best and plainer varieties were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Medium BOPs were firm, the BOPFs followed a similar trend.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOP/BOPFs mostly remained unsold.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs appreciated Rs.100/- to Rs.150/-, the BOPFs too followed a similar trend. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were firm, BOPFs too were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-.

CTC Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s sold at last levels, the High and Medium sorts were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Low Grown CTC PF1s gained Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, the High and Medium sorts were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/.

Low Grown

Select best OP1s sold at last levels, best types eased marginally, however witnessed demand at lower levels, below best types were firm to easier. Select best OPs were firm, others eased from last levels. A few select best OPAs met with fair demand, others declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-. Well twisted BOP1s were firm on last, bolder types were lower by Rs.100/-. All Pekoes were firm to dearer. Shotty Pekoe1s were firm, others met with fair demand.

Select best BOPs were firm, best types were lower by a few rupees, below best and secondary types were firm. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with fair demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best and best FBOPF1s were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-, below best types were irregularly lower, secondary types were firm. Select best FBOPs were firm, best and below best types were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/- and more at times, secondary types too were lower. FF varieties met with fair demand. All Premium Flowery teas met with fair demand.

Off Grades

Select best Fgs1s were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- whilst best types were firm on last levels, below best and poorer sorts appreciated by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. Select best and best BMs were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, below best and poorer types maintained on last levels. Select best and best BPs were firm on last levels whilst, below best and poorer varieties were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Select best BOP1As were dearer by Rs.50/- to Rs.70/-, best types were higher by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- on last levels, below best types maintained on last levels whilst poorer types were lower by Rs.20/-.

Dust

Select best and best Dust1s were firm, below best and plainer varieties declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Select best and best High and Medium CTCs were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, below best and poorer types declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- and more towards the closure. Low Grown CTCs were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- and more towards the closure. Low Grown Dust / Dust1s were firm.








Bright weather with occasional rainfall was reported throughout the week in Galle, Rathnapura and Deniyaya districts.







Improved general demand with prices following quality for the 204,761 packages (13,853,974 kilos) on offer; 47.57% remained unsold.

The multiple reprint tea auction (M4) with 112,820 packages (7,709,090.00 kilos) available saw 85.68% neglected.

MARKETS

Pakistan Packers, Bazaar, Afghanistan, Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries showed strong support with more activity from Egyptian Packers, Kazakhstan, other CIS states and UK. Russia maintained enquiry while Sudan and South Sudan were less active. Local Packers lent more support with Iran showing some interest. Somalia maintained activity at the lower end of the market.

Best – Were steady to dearer by up to USC43.

Brighter – Irregularly dearer by up to USC32 with selected invoices advancing by up to USC73 but a few teas lost up to USC26.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were firm where sold with plantation mediums easier by up to USC33.

Lower Medium – Shed up to USC20 but a few lines were dearer by up to USC7 and select teas gained USC22.

Plainer – Varied between firm to USC7 dearer with select invoices appreciating by USC35 to easier by up to USC9.

<u> PF1:</u>

Best – Were well competed for at steady to USC40 above previous levels.

Brighter – Appreciated by up to USC22.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were mainly firm with some teas dearer by up to USC22 while plantation mediums were irregular varying between steady to USC13 dearer to easier by up to USC10.

Lower Medium – Firm to dearer by up to USC16.

Plainer – Irregular ranging between steady to USC9 dearer to easier by up to USC6.

DUST GRADES (M1)

PDUST:

Best – Saw improved competition and advanced by up to USC28.

Brighter – Firm to USC28 dearer.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were steady with select invoices appreciating by USC17 but a few lines were easier by up to USC6; plantation mediums were irregularly dearer by up to USC31.

Lower Medium – Advanced by up to USC22.

Plainer – were irregular varying between firm to USC13 dearer for most lines to easier by up to USC8.

DUST1:

Best – Appreciated by up to USC22.

Brighter – Steady to USC20 above previous levels.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were mainly firm with a few lines irregular ranging between USC5 dearer to easier by up to USC6. Plantation mediums were well competed for at steady to USC19 dearer.

Lower Medium – Were firm to dearer by up to USC18.

Plainer – Varied between dearer by up to USC13 to USC18 below previous prices.

SECONDARY GRADES (S1)

In the Secondary Catalogues, best **BPs** were dearer while others were about steady with **PFs** selling above previous rates. Clean well sorted coloury **Fannings** appreciated while **similar DUSTs** tended easier. Other **Fannings** held value with **DUSTs** firm. **BMFs** were readily absorbed.

CHITTAGONG MARKET SALE NO. 14 – 12TH AUGUST 2024

CTC LEAF : 65,717 packages of tea on offer met with a fairly good demand.

BROKENS: Well made good liquoring Brokens were again quite a good market but were slightly easier. Medium sorts also met with a fairly good demand and were about steady in line with quality. Plainer types met with a fair demand but prices were slightly easier with some withdrawals. BLF teas met with a selective demand with quite heavy withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Well made good liquoring Fannings were a good market but were slightly easier. Medium types were a fairly good market but eased slightly over last. Plain teas met with some demand but were easier with some withdrawals. BLF teas met with quite a selective demand with quite heavy withdrawals.

DUST: 14,045 packages of tea on offer met with a fair demand. Good liquoring Dusts sold fairly well at last levels. Mediums were an easier market with some withdrawals. Plain/BLF Dusts again had less demand with quite a few withdrawals. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: This was the largest sale this season so far where good teas met with more enquiry over last. Blenders were more active whilst Bazaar showed more support particularly for the well made varieties.

Dusts sold fairly well with some withdrawals.
