0.73Mkg of Ex-Estate teas on offer met with fair demand. Select best Western High Grown BOPs were irregular following quality, the below best and plainer sorts were dearer at times. Select best Western High Grown BOPFs declined from last week's levels, the below best and plainer varieties too were tending lower. Nuwara Eliya BOP / BOPFs mostly remained unsold due to a lack of suitable bids. Uda Pussellawa BOPs gained marginally from last week's levels, the BOPFs were firm to dearer. Uva BOPs declined, the BOPFs were tending easier. Low Grown BP1s were tending irregularly lower, the High and Medium sorts declined. Low Grown CTC PF1s were firm on last levels, the High and Medium sorts mostly declined from last levels.

The 2.5Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with irregular demand. In the Leafy segment, well-made OP / OPAs were irregular, others met with fair demand. OP1s were firm on last. BOP1s were firm. PEKOEs sold at last levels, PEKOE1s were firm to easier. In the Small Leaf segment, FBOPs were lower to last. FBOPF1s too followed a similar trend. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOPSP and BOP grades were firm to easier. FBOPF varieties were lower. Premium Flowery teas declined irregularly.

Turkey, Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.





MARKET DESCRIPTION

Western Teas

Select best Western High Grown BOPs declined irregularly following quality, the below best types were irregularly dearer, however some of the poorer types declined Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Select best Western High Grown BOPFs declined from last levels, below best and plainer varieties too were easier to a lesser extent. Medium BOPs declined by Rs.40/- to Rs.50/-, the BOPFs followed a similar trend.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOP / BOPFs mostly remained unsold due to lack of suitable bids.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs declined from last levels, BOPFs too were barely steady and declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Uda Pussellawa BOPs gained Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- and more at times, the BOPFs too were dearer, by a similar margin.

CTC Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s were tending irregularly lower, the High and Medium sorts declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Low Grown CTC PF1s were firm on last, the High and Medium sorts mostly declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-.

Low Grown

Well twisted OP1s met with fair demand, bolder types along with the secondaries maintained last levels. Select best OPs were firm, best types met with irregular demand, poorer sorts sold at last levels. Select best OPAs were lower to last, best types were irregular, secondaries sold at last levels. Well twisted BOP1s were firm on last, bolder types were lower by Rs.50/-. All Pekoes were firm on last. Shotty Pekoe1s were firm on last, others were irregular.

Select best BOPs were selectively dearer. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with fair demand. BOPFs were easier from last levels. All FBOPF1 were lower by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- and more at times. Select best FBOPs were firm, others declined irregularly. Tippy FBOPF varieties met with fair demand, others were irregular. Well-made Tippy teas with the exception of a few select best invoices met with fair demand, secondary types were mostly lower.

Off Grades

Select best and best FGS1s were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, below best and poorer sorts were firm on last levels. Select best and best BMs were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, below best and poorer types maintained on last levels. Select best and best BPs were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, below best and poorer varieties depreciated by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Select best BOP1As were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, best types maintained on last levels, below best types were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/- whilst poorer types were lower by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/-.

Crop intake is moderate to low.






CTC LEAF: 59,295 packages of teas on offer met with a slightly improved demand.

BROKENS: Good liquoring Brokens were well sought after and sold mostly at firm to occasionally dearer rates following competition. Medium types met with a little more demand and mostly sold at around last levels in line with quality. Plainer types met with a fair demand and were again slightly easier over last. BLF teas met with fair interest with some withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Good liquoring Fannings met with more competition and were mostly dearer in line with quality. Medium varieties were also a good market and sold at around last levels. Plainer types met with a fair demand and were again slightly easier over last. BLF teas met with fair interest with some withdrawals.

DUST: 11,996 packages of teas on offer met with an improved demand and were mostly dearer with only a few withdrawals. Good liquoring Dusts particularly the CDs were a dearer market and advanced in prices. Likewise, Mediums met with a good demand and sold well closely following quality. Plain/BLF Dusts were touch easier with fair withdrawals. Blenders lent strong support with quite fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: There was a slightly better demand this week particularly for all good liquoring varieties. Blenders lent quite useful support with a little more interest from the Loose tea buyers.
