0.8Mkg of Ex- Estate teas on offer met with lower demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs were mostly easier, the below best and plainer sorts too eased from last week's levels. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs were irregularly lower, the below best and plainer sorts followed a similar trend. Nuwara Eliya BOPs / BOPFs mostly remained unsold. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were tending irregular, the BOPFs eased from last week's levels. Uva BOPs appreciated selectively, the BOPFs gained marginally. Low Grown CTC BP1s gained selectively, the High and Medium sorts were easier. Low Grown CTC PF1s were firm to irregular following quality, the High and Medium PF1s were irregular.

The 2.7Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with fair demand. In the Leafy segment, Well-made OPs/OPAs were firm to dearer, others met with good demand. OP1s gained irregularly. BOP1s were firm. PEKOEs were firm to dearer. PEKOE1s followed a similar trend. In the Small Leaf segment, FBOPs were firm. FF1s gained selectively. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOP grades were firm on last. FF varieties were irregular. Premium flowery teas were irregularly lower.

Turkey, Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.





MARKET DESCRIPTION

Western Teas

Select best Western High Grown BOPs declined from last levels, however only a few invoices gained selectively following special inquiry, the below best and plainer varieties were mostly easier. Select best BOPFs were mostly easier, the below best and plainer varieties too declined by Rs.20/to Rs.50/- on average. Medium BOPs were firm to a little easier, the BOPFs were firm to marginally dearer at times.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOP / BOPFs mostly remained unsold.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs appreciated Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- selectively, the BOPFs were firm to Rs.20/- to Rs.30/- dearer at times. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were tending irregular, the BOPFs declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.50/- from last levels.

CTC Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s gained selectively, others were barely steady, the High and Medium sorts were tending easier. Low Grown CTC PF1s were firm to a little irregular following quality, the High and Medium sorts were tending irregular.

Select best BOPs were selectively dearer. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with fair demand. BOPFs were easier from last levels. Select best FBOPF1s were firm to dearer others met with fair demand. Select best FBOPs were firm, others met with fair demand. Tippy FBOPF varieties met with fair demand others were irregular. All Premium Flowery teas were irregularly lower.

Off Grades

Select best and best Fgs1s maintained on last levels, below best and poorer sorts were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Select best and best BMs maintained on last levels, below best and poorer types were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Crop intake is moderate.






MOMBASA MARKET

SALE NO. 39 - SALE OF 23RD / 24TH SEPTEMBER 2024

Good general demand prevailed for the 156,669 packages (10,609,545.00 kilos) on offer with 44.64% unsold.

126,140 packages (8,684,209.00 kilos) were available in the multiple reprint (M4) auction with 95.53% neglected.

MARKETS

Egyptian Packers lent strong support with improved activity from Pakistan Packers. Bazaar, Yemen, other Middle Eastern countries, Kazakhstan and other CIS states maintained useful interest with some activity from Afghanistan. UK showed good but selective support with reduced enquiry from Sudan, China, and South Sudan. Russia and Iran were quiet while Local Packers maintained interest. Somalia were active at the lower end of the market.

LEAF GRADES (M2 & M3)

BP1:

Best – Saw reduced competition and were mostly easier by up to USC12 with select teas discounted by USC51 and USC56; some lines however, appreciated by up to USC11.

Brighter – Were mainly steady with select invoices advance by USC20 and others shed USC68 and USC82.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were firm to easier by up to USC16.

Lower Medium – Were easier by up to USC37 but a few lines gained up to USC34.

Plainer – Firm to USC10 above previous levels.

PF1:

Best - Steady to USC16 dearer.

Brighter – Were firm to USC17 above last rates.

Mediums – KTDA mediums held value with a few lines dearer by up to USC15 while others shed up to USC10. Plantation mediums were irregular varying between steady to dearer by up to USC15 to easier by up to USC17.

Lower Medium – Ranged between firm to USC10 dearer with select invoices appreciating by USC42 to easier by up to USC16.

Plainer – Irregular varying between dearer by up to USC16 to USC10 below previous prices.

DUST GRADES (M1)

PDUST:

Best – Irregular ranging between firm to USC14 dearer to easier by up to USC19.

Brighter – Were mainly easier by up to USC26 but some lines appreciated by up to USC18.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were steady where sold with plantation mediums firm to USC18 dearer.

Lower Medium – Steady to irregularly dearer by up to USC26.

Plainer – appreciated by up to USC6, a few lines however shed up to USC8.





MOMBASA MARKET – Continued;

DUST1:

Best – Steady to USC9 dearer to easier by a similar margin.

Brighter – Firm to USC30 above previous prices but some lines shed up to USC20.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were steady to USC4 dearer to easier by up to USC10 with a number of teas remaining unsold. Plantation mediums were firm to dearer by up to USC10.

Lower Medium – Were irregular with some teas appreciating by up to USC12 while others eased by up to USC6.

Plainer – Varied between USC22 with select teas advancing by USC33 dearer to easier by up to USC6.

SECONDARY GRADES (S1)

In the Secondary Catalogues, best BPs tended easier while others held value with PFs steady. Clean well sorted coloury Fannings appreciated while similar DUSTs were firm. Other Fannings were steady with DUSTs selling at previous rates. BMFs were well absorbed.

CTC LEAF: 57,211 packages of teas on offer continued to meet with a good demand.

BROKENS: All good liquoring varieties were again a strong market, and these were firm to occasionally dearer following competition. Medium varieties also met with a good demand and sold at around last levels easing slightly in line with quality. Plainer types met with quite a fair demand at slightly easier rates. BLF teas met with fair interest and witnessed little more withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Good liquoring Fannings were quite a strong market and were mostly firm to occasionally dearer. Medium varieties met with a fairly good demand at around last levels. Plainer types met with fair demand at slightly easier rates. BLF teas met with fair interest and witnessed some withdrawals.

DUST: 12,454 packages of teas on offer met with good demand. Good liquoring Dusts sold well at around last levels. Their Mediums were fully firm to slightly dearer closely following quality. There was a little less competition for Medium and Plainer teas resulting in a fair decline. Blenders continued to lend strong support, but Loose tea buyers were a little less active.
