The 0.71Mkg of Ex-Estate teas on offer met with lower demand. Select best Western High Grown BOPs declined together with the below best and plainer varieties. Select best BOPF were generally easier, the below best and plainer sorts too declined. Nuwara Eliya BOPs were mostly unsold, the BOPFs declined from last levels. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were irregularly easier, the BOPFs too followed a similar trend. UVA BOPs were barely steady, the BOPFs too were slightly easier. Low Grown CTC BP1s maintained last levels, the High and Medium sorts were tending irregular. The Low Grown CTC PF1s declined sharply, whilst the High and Medium sorts were tending irregular.

The 1.8Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with fair demand. In the Leafy segment, OP/OPAs were irregularly lower. OP1s declined following quality. BOP1s were firm to easier. Pekoe / Pekoe1s were mostly firm. In the Small Leaf segment, FBOPs were lower. Well-made FBOPF1s were firm, others too followed a similar trend. FBOPF varieties showed reasonable interest. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOP grades met fair demand. Premium Flowery teas were firm.

Turkey, Russia and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Iran showed continuous support. Libya and Iraq were active.







MARKET DESCRIPTION

Western Teas

Select best BOPs declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- and more, below best and plainer varieties too were barely steady. Select best BOPFs declined by Rs.100/- to Rs.150/- and more, the below best and plainer sorts were easier by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-. Medium BOPs were firm to Rs.50/- easier, the BOPFs were irregularly lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/- and more.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOPs mostly remained unsold, the BOPFs too declined by Rs.100/- and more.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs were barely steady, the BOPFs too were slightly easier. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were irregularly easier with some invoices remaining unsold, the BOPFs were irregularly easier and declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.70/- at times.

CTC Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s were firm, the High and Medium sorts were tending irregular. Low Grown CTC PF1s declined Rs.100/- to Rs.150/- and more, the High and Medium sorts too were mostly easier by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-.

Low Grown

Select best OP1s were firm, best and below best types declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, stalky secondaries too were lower to last. OPs in general tended lower to last. Select best OPAs were firm, others experienced a general decline with irregular demand. Select best BOP1s were firm, bolder types tended lower. Well-made Pekoes along with the heavy bold Pekoes met with good demand, secondaries were firm to easier. Shotty Pekoe1s were firm on last level, secondaries met with irregular demand.

Select best and best BOPs were firm, below best and secondary types were firm to dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with lower demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best FBOPF1s were firm, best types were irregularly lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- and below best types were firm, secondary types too were firm. Well-made FBOPs in the select best category were firm, best and below best types were lower by Rs.60/- to Rs.80/- and more following quality, secondary types were firm. FBOPF varieties met with reasonable demand. All Premium Flowery teas met with fair demand.

Off Grades

Select best and best Fgs1 depreciated by Rs.60/- to Rs.80/- and more at times, below best and poorer sorts were lower by Rs.50/- to Rs.70/-. Select best and best BMs maintained on last levels, below best and poorer types were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/- and more at times. Select best and best BPs were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- whilst below best and poorer types maintained on last levels. Select best BOP1As were lower by Rs.60/- to Rs.80/-, best types were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.80/-, below best types were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- to Rs.40/- to Rs.40/-, whilst poorer sorts maintained on last levels.

Bright weather with occasional rainfall was recorded in Deniyaya, Rathnapura and Galle districts.







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TEA NEWS AROUND THE GLOBE

CHITTAGONG MARKET SALE NO.22 – 25TH SEPTEMBER 2023

CTC LEAF: 76,297 packages of tea on offer met with a fair demand with heavier withdrawals.

BROKENS: A few select lines of good Brokens met with a fair demand and sold at around last levels but all others declined in price and witnessed heavy withdrawals, particularly the plainest. BLF teas met with less demand with much more withdrawals.

FANNINGS: A few lines of good Fannings met with a fairly good demand and mostly sold at around last levels and often shedding Tk.2/- to Tk.4/-. Medium Fannings met with less demand and where sold recorded a further drop and there were more withdrawals. Plain types witnessed much less demand and were mostly withdrawn owing to lack of bids. BLF teas met with less demand with much more withdrawals

CTC DUST: 14,388 packages of tea on offer met with a good demand. Good liquoring Dusts met with good demand at easier rates. Medium teas met with a fair demand with some withdrawals. Plain and BLF Dusts met with less demand and had some withdrawals. Blenders were fairly active. Loose tea buyers were selective.

COMMENTS: A record weight of tea was on offer in this sale which mainly comprised of reprints from the previous sales. Blenders lent fairly good support but were holding lower limits. There was less demand from the Loose tea buyers particularly for the re-printed teas.


