The 0.74Mkg of Ex Estates teas on offer met with fair demand. Select best Western High Grown BOPs declined from last week's levels, the below best and plainer sorts were firm to irregularly lower. Select best BOPFs were firm to marginally lower, below best and plainer varieties were dearer at the commencement and eased as the sale progressed. Nuwara Eliya BOPs were irregular but mostly easier, the BOPFs were mostly unsold. Udapussellawa BOPs declined however, the BOPFs gained sharply at times following quality and special inquiry. Uva BOPs were firm, the BOPFs were irregularly dearer. Low Grown CTC BP1s were firm to dearer at times, the PF1s were firm on last levels. The High and Medium BP1s were firm to easier with some invoices remaining unsold, the High and Medium PF1s were firm to dearer following quality.

The 2.6Mkg of Low Grown teas which were on offer met with fair demand. Select best OP1s were lower, best and below best OP1s too met with lower demand. BOP1s attracted fair interest. Select best OPAs were firm, best and below best types shed few rupees, others were substantially lower. Well-made Bold Pekoes were firm, mixed varieties shed few rupees. Well-made Shotty Pekoe1s were firm, others were lower. In the Small Leaf segment, select best BOP.SP / BOPF.SP and BOPFs met with improved demand. Select best BOPs gained following quality. Select best and best FBOPs were firm, others too attracted fair interest. Select best FBOPF1s maintained last levels, best and below best varieties maintained last levels. FBOPFs attracted improved interest. Best Premium Flowery teas met with lower demand, others were firm.

Turkey, Russia, Iran and the C.I.S. countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.





MARKET DESCRIPTION

Western Teas

The select best BOPs were easier by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/- whist the below best and plainer sorts were mostly firm. Select best BOPFs too eased by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, the below best and plainer sorts however were irregularly dearer at times. Best Medium BOPs maintained, however the balance were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, BOPFs too were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOPs were lower to last, BOPFs met with less demand and were difficult of sale.

Uva Teas

BOPs were firm, better BOPFs appreciated by Rs.10/-, however the balance met with irregular demand. Udapussellawa BOPs declined sharply, whilst the balance met with irregular demand, BOPFs were irregular.

CTC Teas

Low Grown BP1s maintained, PF1s were firm. There was hardly any Medium Grown BP1s on offer, PF1s met with irregular demand. There was hardly any High Grown BP1s on offer, PF1s were firm and at times Rs.10/- to Rs.20/- dearer, the balance were firm.

MARKET DESCRIPTION

Low Grown

Select best wiry OP1s along with the other better twisted invoices declined noticeably, reducers too shed from last levels. Better twisted BOP1s with the exception of few select best invoices gained irregularly, bolder types too met with reasonable demand. Better twisted OPs were mostly lower, reducers too met with lesser demand. Select best OPAs were firm, best and below best types declined by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, secondary OPAs declined sharply. Pekoes in the select best category held firm, below best types declined by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/- and more at times, heavy bold Pekoe invoices too declined irregularly. Shotty Pekoe1s met with reasonable demand, best and below best categories along with the clean reducers were mostly lower.

Select best well-made BOPs were firm, best types were dearer by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, below best BOPs were firm, secondary types were lower by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-. Select best and best BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with good demand, others were firm. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best FBOPF1s were firm, best FBOPF1s were dearer by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/- and more following quality, below best FBOPF1s and poor secondaries were lower by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-. Well-made FBOPs in the select best category met with fair demand, best types were firm, below best and secondary types too were lower by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-. FBOPF varieties met with very good demand. Select best Premium Flowery teas were firm to easier by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, others were firm on last levels.

Off Grades

Select best and best FGS1s were declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, below best and poorer types were firm. Select best and best BMs were firm, whilst below best and poorer types were dearer by Rs.10/-. All BPs showed an irregular demand. All BOP1As were dearer by Rs.10/-.

Dust

Select best and best Dust1s were irregularly dearer by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, below best types sold at firm levels, poorer sorts sold at last levels. High and Medium CTCs depreciated by Rs.10/- to Rs.15/- and more at times as the sale progressed. Low Grown CTCs met with fair demand. Low Grown Dust / Dust1 sold at firm levels.

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MOMBASA MARKET

SALE NO. 39 - SALE OF 27TH / 28TH SEPTEMBETR 2021

Good but irregular demand prevailed for the 125,919 packages (8,339,632.00 kilos) in the market closely following quality with 21.66% remaining unsold.

LEAF GRADES

Offerings: 65,159 packages (4,253,565.00 kilos). 24.43% were unsold. The best BP1s available were discounted by USC11 to USC28 but a few invoices held steady with brighter types about firm to USC16 below last week's levels while medium categories eased by USC4 to USC6 and some lines remained without bids but a few improved invoices were steady. Lower medium sorts met an irregular activity and ranged between firm to USC6 dearer to easier by USC2 to USC48 and many lines remained unsold. Plainer categories varied between USC2 to USC6 above last prices to easier by USC2 to USC10 with some invoices neglected.

Best PF1s on offer were irregular with quality varying between firm to USC28 dearer to easier by up to USC14 with brighter varieties advancing by USC10 to USC22 and a few lines remained without bids. Medium categories held firm to USC10 above previous week's rates but a few invoices were unsold while lower mediums saw an irregular enquiry ranging between USC19 dearer to easier by a similar rate and some invoices were unsold. Plainer descriptions varied between firm to USC14 above last week's prices to easier by USC3 to USC9 with some lines neglected.

DUST GRADES

Offerings: 41,500 packages (3,095,741.00 kilos) with 20.72% remaining unsold. Best PDUSTs available appreciated by USC16 to USC18 following quality while brighter varieties met better absorption and gained USC7 to USC32 closely following quality with medium categories steady to USC24 above previous week's levels. Improved lower medium types saw better interest advancing by USC3 to USC26 while others shed USC4 to USC18 and some invoices were unsold with plainer sorts irregular varying between firm to USC22 dearer following quality to easier by USC2 to USC8 and many lines were neglected.

The best DUST1s on offer gained USC2 to USC16 with brighter categories advancing by USC6 to USC22 with quality while medium varieties saw improved enquiry and were steady to USC45 above last prices closely following quality. Lower medium types met an irregular activity ranging between firm to USC13 dearer to easier by USC2 to USC6 and some lines remained unsold. Plainer categories varied between USC2 to USC6 above last week's rates to easier by USC2 to USC42 and many invoices were unsold.

SECONDARY GRADES.

Offerings: 19,260 packages (990,326.00 kilos) with 14.33% unsold. In the Secondary Catalogues, BPs were dearer while PFs gained. Clean well sorted coloury Fannings appreciated with DUSTs advancing. Other Fannings were steady while similar DUSTs gained. BMFs were well absorbed.

MARKETS

Pakistan Packers showed strong enquiry and were forceful with more and strong support from Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries and were dominant while UK lent more and strong interest. There was increased activity from Russia while Egyptian Packers and Sudan showed useful support with reduced interest from Kazakhstan, other CIS nations and Bazaar. Iran and Afghanistan were subdued while Local Packers operated in line with price. Somalia lent strong support at the lower end of the market.

SALE NO. 20 – 27TH SEPTEMBER 2021

CTC LEAF: 47,515 packages of Current Season and 147 packages of Old Season teas on offer met with a fairly strong demand.

BROKENS: Well made good liquoring Brokens were a strong market and were mostly dearer by Tk.1/- to Tk.2/-. Their Medium types were fully firm to occasionally dearer. Plain and BLF teas met with a fair demand and were about steady.

FANNINGS: Good liquoring Fannings once again met with a good demand and tended dearer. Medium varieties were also a good market and were slightly dearer following competition. Plain and BLF teas met with a little more demand and were fully firm.

CTC DUST: 11,667 packages of Current Season and 43 packages of Old Season teas on offer met with a good demand. Select best liquoring teas were around last levels. The remainder were fully firm to slightly dearer. Their mediums were also dearer by Tk.2/- to Tk.3/-. Plain and BLF Dusts were an easier market and witnessed fair withdrawals. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: Good liquoring teas continued to be well sought after and were generally a little dearer. Both Blenders and Loose tea buyers were more active this week. As a result, there were a little less withdrawals.

Dusts sold well.

- Demand : good for quality and fair for remainder.
- Levels eased more so for teas which showed a drop in quality.
