COMMENTS



Tea Exports for the month of September was recorded at 19.7Mkg which is a decline of 14.5% when compared with the same period of the previous year, and also a decline of 10% against the month of August 2024. The average unit FOB value per kg. was Rs.109.08 above the average unit value per kg in September 2023. The cumulative Export quantity for the year recorded a positive variance of 0.87Mkg against the corresponding period. The cumulative average FOB value recorded a decline of Rs.11.61 against last year's average FOB price. Therefore, the value of Tea Exports for the period (January- September) in 2024 recorded a positive variance of Rs. 5.6 million over the previous year. Iraq emerged as the leading importer of Sri Lanka Tea with a volume of 24.1Mkg followed by other major importers such as Russia, U.A.E, Turkey and China.

0.9Mkg of Ex- Estate teas on offer met with lower demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs along with the below best and plainer varieties declined from last levels. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs were substantially easier, the below best and plainer varieties declined to a lesser extent and eased further as the sale progressed, with a large number of invoices remaining unsold. Nuwara Eliya BOPs sold well, the BOPFs mostly remained unsold due to a lack of suitable bids. Uda Pussellawa BOPs barely maintained, the BOPFs were tending easier. Uva BOPs were barely steady and mostly easier from last week's levels, the BOPFs declined marginally. Low Grown CTC BP1s were easier with some invoices remaining unsold, the High and Medium sorts were barely steady and were mostly easier. Low Grown CTC PF1s declined from last levels, the High and Medium sorts were irregularly easier.

The 2.4Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with lower demand. In the Leafy segment, Well-made OPs/OPAs were firm, others met with irregular demand. OP1s were lower to last. BOP1s too followed a similar trend. PEKOEs declined from last levels. PEKOE1s were firm to easier. In the Small Leaf segment, FBOPs in general were lower. FF1s declined from last levels. The BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOP grades were firm on last levels. FF varieties were firm. Premium flowery teas were irregular.

Turkey, Russia and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.





MARKET DESCRIPTION

Western Teas

Select best Western High Grown BOPs declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.60/- and more, below best and plainer sorts too declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/-. Select best Western High Grown BOPFs declined substantially, below best and plainer varieties eased Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-. Medium BOPs were easier, the BOPFs too commenced lower and declined further as the sale progressed.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOPs sold well, the BOPFs mostly remained unsold.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs were barely steady and were mostly easier from last levels, the BOPFs declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- at times. Uda Pussellawa BOPs barely maintained, the BOPFs were tending easier by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-

CTC Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s were easier and some invoices remining unsold, the High and Medium sorts were barely steady and were mostly easier. Low Grown CTC PF1s declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, the High and Medium sorts were irregularly easier by Rs.20/- to Rs.50/-.

Low Grown

Well twisted wiry OP1s declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- and more at times, below best types along with the secondaries however met with fair demand. Well twisted OPs were firm, others met with mixed interest. Select best and best OPAs were firm on last, secondaries were irregular. Select best BOP1s along with the best types were firm, others were easier. All Pekoes were lower to last. Well-made Pekoe1s met with irregular demand, others were firm to lower.

Well made BOPs were firm, others were lower. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with irregular demand. BOPFs were firm on last levels. Few select best FBOPF1s were firm on last, others were lower to last. Better twisted FBOPs were firm to easier, bolder types declined substantially. Tippy FBOPF varieties met with fair demand, others were irregular. Premium Flowery teas were irregular with only the FBOPF.SPs varieties attracting fair demand.

Off Grades

Select best and best Fgs1s depreciated by Rs.30/- to Rs.50/- and more towards the closure, below best and poorer sorts maintained on last levels. Select best and best BMs were lower by Rs.10./- to Rs.20/-, below best and poorer types were firm on last levels. Select best and best BPs depreciated by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- and more towards the closure, below best and poorer varieties were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-. Select best BOP1As were lower by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, best types were lower by Rs.80/- to Rs.100/-, below best types were maintained on last levels, whilst poorer types were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-.

Dust

Select best Dust1s declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/- and more, best types were firm, below best types were dearer by Rs.20/-, poorer types were easier by Rs.20/-. Select best and best High and Medium CTCs were firm, below best and poorer types declined by Rs.40/-. Low Grown CTCs were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Low Grown Dust / Dust1s were declined by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/- and more.








Crop intake is moderate to low.






MARKETS

Pakistan Packers, Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries maintained support but at lower rates while Afghanistan and Bazaar were quiet. Kazakhstan and other CIS states were strong with UK active but at lower levels. Egyptian Packers were active while Russia were more selective. Sudan showed more participation with increased absorption from South Sudan. China reduced enquiry with Local Packers less active. Somalia maintained activity at the lower end of the market.
