## **COMMENTS**



The 0.7Mkg of Ex-Estate teas on offer met with irregularly lower demand. A few Select Best Western High Grown BOPs gained following special inquiry, whilst the others declined from last week's levels, the below best and plainer varieties too were irregularly easier. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs were marginally easier, the below best and plainer sorts too were easier and declined further as the sale progressed. Nuwara Eliya BOPs gained from last week's levels, the BOPFs met with fair demand. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were easier and barely maintained last levels, the BOPFs declined. UVA BOPs too were a lower feature, whilst the BOPFs followed a similar trend. Low Grown CTC BP1s maintained last levels, the High and Medium sorts were mostly firm. Low grown CTC PF1s were firm on last levels, whilst the High and Medium sorts were irregularly lower.

The 2.1Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with reasonable demand. In the Leafy segment, OP/OPA's were dearer. OP1s met with good demand. BOP1s appreciated following quality. PEKs were irregularly lower by a few rupees, PEK1s maintained. In the Small Leaf segment, well-made FBOPs were firm, others were lower. FF1s shed a few rupees. FF varieties declined substantially. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOP grades met with irregular demand. Premium flowery teas were lower to last.

Turkey, Russia and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Iran was selective. Libya and Iraq were active.





## **MARKET DESCRIPTION**

### **Western Teas**

Select best BOPs were irregular following quality, with only a handful of invoices appreciating whilst most others declined, below best sorts too were lower by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-. Select best BOPFs were barely steady and mostly easier by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-, below best and plainer sorts too eased Rs.50/- at the commencement of the sale and declined further as the sale progressed. Medium BOPs were firm on last, the BOPFs too followed a similar trend.

### **Nuwara Eliya Teas**

BOPs gained following special inquiry, the BOPFs too were dearer.

### **Uva Teas**

Uva BOPs were easier by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/-, the BOPFs were easier by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were easier by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/-, the BOPFs declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- and more.

### **CTC Teas**

Low Grown CTC BP1s were firm on last, the High and Medium sorts too were firm to a little dearer at times. Low Grown CTC PF1s were firm, the High and Medium sorts were irregularly lower following quality.

## MARKET DESCRIPTION



### **Low Grown**

Select best OP1s were irregularly dearer, best and below best types too met with fair demand, secondaries were irregular. Better twisted OPs were firm to dearer following quality, below best sorts too met with fair demand. The market for OPAs faired similar to OPs. In the Semi Leafy segment, all BOP1s were firm to dearer by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-. Well-made Pekoes were firm, bolder types met with fair demand, below best types however declined irregularly. Shotty Pekoe1s were firm on last, others too met with fair demand.

Select best BOPs were firm, best and below best types were lower by Rs. 40/- to Rs. 60/-, secondary types were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with reasonable demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best FBOPF1s were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/- best and below best types were substantially lower, secondary types were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-. Well-made FBOPs in the select best category were firm, best and below best types were lower by Rs.60/- to Rs.80/- and more following quality, secondary types were firm. FBOPF varieties met with lower demand. Smaller Tippy Premium Flowery teas met with lower demand; Wiry long Tippy varieties met with good demand.

### **Off Grades**

Select best and best Fgs1s were dearer by Rs.30/- to Rs.50/- and more towards the closure, below best and poorer sorts met with a reasonable demand. Select best and best BMs were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- and more at times, below best and poorer types were irregularly lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Select best BPs appreciated by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- whilst best BPs were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/- and more at times, below best and poorer varieties maintained on last levels. Select best BOP1As were higher by Rs.60/- to Rs.120/-, best types were higher by Rs.20/- to Rs.50/-, below best types were higher by Rs.30/- to Rs.60/-, whilst poorer sorts maintained on last levels.

## **Dust**

Select best Dust1s were firm, best, below best and plainer varieties declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- and more towards the closure, poorer sorts were firm. Select best and best High and Medium CTCs were firm, below best and plainer sorts showed an irregular demand. Low Grown CTCs were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Low Grown Dust/Dust1s were firm.

Crop intakes are low.






There was reduced demand at irregular levels following quality for the 208,200 packages (13,959,729.00 kilos) on offer with 30.86% remaining unsold.

#### **MARKETS**

Kazakhstan and other CIS states lent good but selective interest with reduced enquiry from Egyptian Packers, Pakistan Packers, Afghanistan, UK, Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries. Bazaar operated at lower levels while South Sudan showed improved support. Russia, Sudan and Iran remained quiet while Local Packers maintained support. Somalia were active at the lower end of the market.

#### **LEAF GRADES (M2)**

#### **BP1**:

Best – Saw irregular interest with teas varying between steady to USC32 dearer and selected invoices appreciated by USC62 and USC113 to easier by up to USC18.

Brighter – Advanced by up to USC32 with selected lines gaining USC56 but some teas shed up to USC21.

Mediums – KTDA mediums held value with a number of invoices neglected while plantation mediums were irregular ranging between firm to USC42 dearer to easier by up to USC17. Lower Medium – Were steady to irregularly dearer by up to USC33.

**Plainer** – Varied between USC9 dearer to easier by up to USC8.

#### PF1:

Best – Irregular ranging between steady to USC29 dearer to easier by up to USC32.

Brighter - Varied between firm to USC6 dearer to USC15 below last rates.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were mostly steady at reserve prices with a few lines irregular ranging between USC7 dearer to up to USC4 below previous levels. Plantation mediums were steady to easier by up to USC21 but a few teas advanced by up to USC8.

Lower Medium – Shed up to USC18.

Plainer – Were irregular ranging between firm to USC13 dearer

#### **DUST GRADES (M1)**

### PDUST:

Best – Were firm to USC31 easier for most teas with a few lines advancing by up to USC18.

Brighter – Lost up to USC31.

Mediums – KTDA mediums held value with plantation mediums ranging between firm to USC14 dearer to easier by up to USC20.

Lower Medium – Were irregular and varied between USC30 dearer to USC20 below previous levels.

Plainer – Steady to easier by up to USC24.

CTC LEAF: 63,365 packages of tea on offer met with an improved demand.

BROKENS: All good liquoring Brokens met with a better demand and were fully firm to slightly dearer following competition. Other varieties also met with a fairly good demand but were slightly easier in line with quality. Plain types were again a slightly easier market with some withdrawals. BLF teas met with a fair demand at around last levels with some withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Good liquoring Fannings met with a fairly strong demand and were again fully firm to slightly dearer following competition. Medium varieties met with a fair demand and sold at around last levels easing in line with quality. Plain types were again slightly easier with some withdrawals. BLF teas met with a fair demand at around last levels with some withdrawals.

CTC DUST: 11,662 packages of tea on offer met with good demand. Good liquoring Dusts sold well at dearer rates. Mediums were in fair demand with few withdrawals. Plain and BLF Dusts had fair demand with some withdrawals. Blenders were active with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.
