The 0.64Mkg of Ex-Estate teas on offer met with fair demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs appreciated following special inquiry, the below best and plainer varieties too improved from last levels. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs were firm to irregularly dearer following quality and special inquiry, the below best and plainer sorts were firm to irregularly easier at times. Nuwara Eliya BOPs were tending irregular, the BOPFs were dearer following special inquiry. Uda Pussellawa BOPs appreciated, selected invoices of BOPF gained substantially at times, the others were dearer. UVA BOPs appreciated, the BOPFs too gained from last levels. Low Grown CTC BP1s were dearer, the High and Medium sorts followed a similar trend. Low grown CTC PF1s were irregularly easier following quality, the High and Medium sorts were irregularly dearer.

The 2.4Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with reasonable demand. In the Leafy segment, well-made OPA's were firm, others were irregularly lower, OPs declined a few rupees. Well-made OP1s gained following quality, others were irregularly lower. BOP1s maintained last levels. PEKs declined sharply, PEK1s too shed a few rupees. In the Small Leaf segment, well-made FBOPs were firm, others were lower. Best FF1s improved following quality, others were firm. FF varieties met with reasonable demand. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOP grades met with fair interest. Premium flowery teas were firm.

Turkey, Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.

Select best Western High Grown BOPs appreciated irregularly following special inquiry, the below best and plainer varieties gained Rs.100/- to Rs.150/-. Select best Western High Grown BOPFs were dearer following quality and special inquiry, the below best and plainer varieties were firm to irregularly easier at times. Medium BOPs were dearer, the BOPFs were firm on last levels.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOPs were irregular, the BOPFs gained sharply following special inquiry.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs appreciated by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, the BOPFs too gained Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- at times. The limited volume of Uda Pussellawa BOPs appreciated by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, the BOPFs too were dearer by Rs.100/- to Rs.150/- and more following special inquiry.

CTC Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s were dearer by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, the High and Medium sorts too followed a similar trend. Low Grown PF1s were firm to irregularly easier at times, the High and Medium sorts were firm to irregularly dearer.

Low Grown

Select best wiry OP1s met with good demand, other well twisted OP1s in the best category were firm on last levels, below best sorts were firm to dearer, stalky poor secondaries were firm. Select best OP/ OPAs met with fair demand, however the below best sorts were lower to last. Well-made BOP1s met with fair demand, the bolder types were lower to last. Well-made Pekoes along with the bolder types were irregularly lower, secondaries too were mostly easier. Shotty Pekoe1s and the poorer sorts reduced as the sale progressed.

Select best BOPs were lower by Rs.30/- to Rs.50/-, best and below best types were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, secondary types too were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with good demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best and best FBOPF1s were firm to dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, below best types were firm, secondary types were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Well-made FBOPs in the select best category were firm, best and below best types were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/- and more following quality, secondary types were firm. Select best and best BMs were lower by Rs.30/- to Rs.50/-, whilst below best and poorer types declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- and more at times. Select best and Best BPs were firm, whilst below best and poorer varieties maintained on last levels. Crop intakes are low.






CHITTAGONG MARKET

SALE NO. 29 - 13TH NOVEMBER 2023

CTC LEAF: 70,057 packages of tea on offer met with a fair demand generally at easier rates.

BROKENS: Large Brokens continued to be a difficult market owing to lack of demand and where sold registered a drop in price. Small Brokens met with a slightly better demand and were about steady. Plain types saw only a fair demand and prices eased further with more withdrawals. BLF teas met with some interest at around last levels and there were fair withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Good Fannings met with a better demand particularly for the bright liquoring types. Medium and other descriptions also met with a fair demand but eased following quality. There were fair withdrawals. BLF teas met with some interest at around last levels and there were fair withdrawals.

CTC DUST: 13,792 packages of tea on offer met with a fair demand. Good liquoring Dusts sold well with some withdrawals. Mediums were a fair market with Tk.5/- to Tk.8/- less than last levels. Plain and BLF Dusts were an easier market with some withdrawals. Blenders were fairly active whilst Loose tea buyers were very selective.

COMMENTS: There was a better tone in the market whereby a few teas were competed for and their values held firm particularly for the improved liquoring types. Other varieties met with a fair demand and dropped in price. Blenders were active with a little more support from the Loose tea buyers. Dusts were a fair market with some withdrawals.
