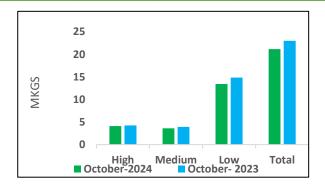


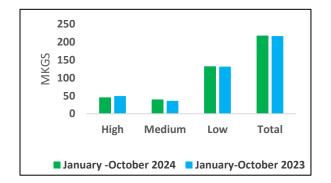




Sri Lanka harvested a crop of 21.1Mkg during the month of October 2024 which is a decline of 8% when compared to the crop harvested in October 2023. The main contributor for the 21.1Mkg was from the Low Grown planting districts with 63.5%, followed by High Growns at 19.4% and the Medium Growns at 17.1%. When compared with the crop in October 2023, negative variances were recorded in the High Growns at 3%, Medium Growns at 8% and Low Growns at 9%.

Tea Exports for the month of October 2024 was recorded at 20.7Mkg which is a growth of 14% when compared with the same period of the previous year. The average unit FOB value per kg. was Rs.86.54 above the average unit value per kg in October 2023. The cumulative Export quantity for the year recorded a positive variance of 3.4Mkg against the corresponding period. The cumulative average FOB value recorded a marginal decline against last year's average FOB price. Therefore, the value of Tea Exports for the period (January- October) in 2024 recorded a positive variance of Rs.5.6 billion over the previous year. Iraq emerged as the leading importer of Sri Lanka Tea with a volume of 27.1Mkg followed by other major importers such as Russia, U.A.E , Turkey and China.

0.70Mkg of Ex- Estate teas on offer met with irregularly lower demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs appreciated selectively following special inquiry, the below best and plainer varieties were firm to easier. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs gained following special inquiry, the below best and plainer sorts were irregularly lower. Nuwara Eliya BOPs were firm, the BOPFs mostly remained unsold. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were barely steady, the BOPFs were firm to marginally dearer. Uva BOPs declined from last levels, the BOPFs were irregular and mostly easier. Low Grown CTC BP1s met with lower demand, the High and Medium sorts were firm to dearer. Low Grown CTC PF1s were easier and tending irregular, the High and Medium sorts were firm to irregular following quality.

The 2.5Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with fair demand. In the Leafy segment, Well-made OPs/OPAs were firm to dearer, others met with good demand. All OP1s gained from last levels. BOP1s were firm. PEKOEs were firm to dearer. PEKOE1s were irregularly lower. In the Small Leaf segment, FBOPs sold at last levels . FF1s were marginally lower. The BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOP grades met with mixed demand. FF varieties were firm to easier. Premium flowery teas declined irregularly.

Turkey, Russia and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.





#### **Western Teas**

Select best Western High Grown BOPs gained Rs.50/- and more selectively following special inquiry, the below best and plainer varieties were firm to marginally easier. Select best Western High Grown BOPFs gained selectively by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/- following special inquiry, the below best and plainer varieties were irregularly lower. Medium BOPs were tending irregular, the BOPFs were firm to Rs.50/- easier.

#### Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOPs were firm, the BOPFs mostly remained unsold.

#### **Uva Teas**

Uva BOPs declined by Rs.50/- and more from last week's levels, the BOPFs were irregularly lower. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were barely steady, the BOPFs were firm to Rs.20/- dearer.

#### **CTC Teas**

Low Grown CTC BP1s mostly remained unsold, the High and Medium sorts were firm to a little dearer at times. Low Grown CTC PF1s were easier and tending irregular, the High and Medium sorts were firm to irregular following quality.

## **MARKET DESCRIPTION**



#### Low Grown

Select best OP1s along with the teas sold in the best and below best categories met with good demand, secondaries too were firm to dearer. Well-made OPs met with improved demand, below best sorts were irregular. Select best OPAs were firm, best and below best types met with improved demand. Select best BOP1s were firm, best types met with good demand, others were firm. Well-made Pekoes were firm, best types along with the bolder types were dearer. Shotty Pekoe1s were firm, others were easier.

Select best BOPs were firm to selectively dearer, others sold on last levels. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs were lower to last. BOPFs were firm. A few select best FBOPF1s were firm on last, whilst the best and below best types were firm to dearer. Better twisted FBOPs were firm, and bolder types were firm to dearer. Tippy FBOPF varieties were firm to last, others met with fair demand. Premium Flowery teas gained selectively.

#### **Off Grades**

Select best and best Fgs1s were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.80/- and more towards the closure, below best and poorer sorts depreciated by Rs. 20/- to Rs.40/-. Select best and best BMs were firm on last levels, below best and poorer types were lower by Rs.30/- to Rs.40/-. Select best and best BPs depreciated by Rs.60/- to Rs.80/- and more towards the closure, below best and poorer varieties were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-. Select best BOP1As were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, best types maintained on last levels, below best types were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, whilst poorer types were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-.

#### Dust

Select best Dust1s were firm, best types were easier by Rs.20/-, below best and poorer types declined by Rs.40/-. Select best and best High and Medium CTCs were firm, others declined by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Low Grown CTCs declined by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/- and more. Select best and best Low Grown Dust / Dust1s declined by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-, below best and poorer types declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/-.

Crop intake is moderate.

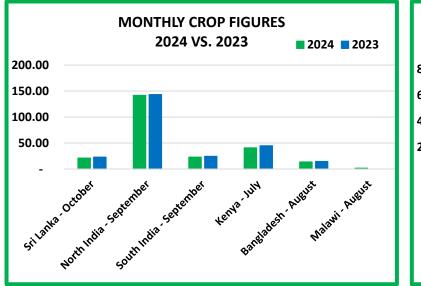


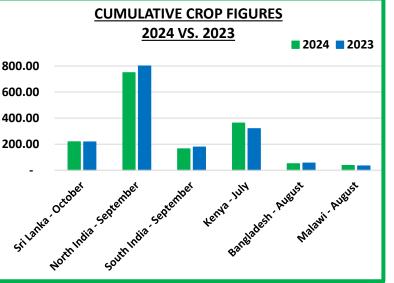
