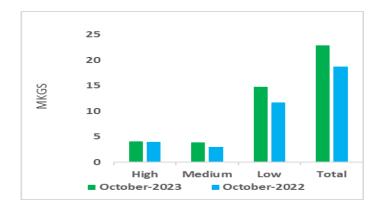
COMMENTS

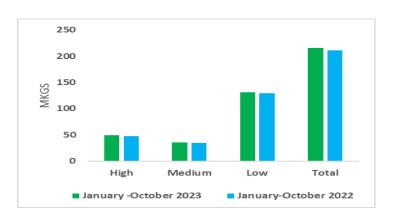


Sri Lanka harvested a crop of 22.8Mkg during the Month of October 2023, which is an increase of 22% when compared to the crop harvested in October 2022.

The main contributor for the 22.8Mkg was from the Low Grown planting districts with 64.8%, followed by High Growns at 18% and the Medium Growns at 17.1%. When compared with the crop in October 2022, positive variances have been recorded in all three elevations with High Growns at 4%, Medium Growns at 28% and the Low Growns at 26%.

COMMENTS – Cont'd...



Sri Lanka Tea Exports for the month of October 2023 was recorded at 18.2Mkg which is a decline of 4% when compared with the same period of the previous year. The average unit FOB value per kg. was Rs.372.22 below the average unit value per kg of October 2022. The cumulative Export quantity for the year recorded a negative variance of 11.9Mkg against the corresponding period. The cumulative average FOB value recorded an increase of Rs.200.36 against last year's average FOB price. As a result, the value of Tea Exports for the period (January- October) in 2023 recorded a positive variance of Rs.21.2 billion over the previous year. Iraq emerged as the leading importer of Sri Lanka Tea and the other major importers were Turkey, Russia, U.A.E and China.

The 0.65Mkg of Ex-Estate teas on offer met with improved demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs were firm to irregularly dearer following quality, the below best and plainer varieties too appreciated from last levels. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs were firm to dearer at times, the below best and plainer sorts were mostly dearer. There were hardly any Nuwara Eliya BOPs on offer, the BOPFs were tending dearer. Uda Pussellawa BOPs gained from last week's levels, BOPF too followed a similar trend, with price levels fluctuating following quality. UVA BOPs were dearer, the BOPFs appreciated from last levels. Low Grown CTC BP1s were tending dearer following special inquiry, the High and Medium sorts were irregularly dearer. Low Grown CTC PF1s were mostly firm on last levels, the High and Medium sorts too followed a similar trend.

The 2.3Mkg of Low Grown teas on offer met with fair demand. In the Leafy segment, well-made OPA's along with the OPs were firm. Select best OP1s gained following quality, others were mostly firm. BOP1s maintained last levels. PEKs and PEK1s met with lower interest. In the Small Leaf segment, well-made FBOPs were dearer, others were firm. Best FF1s improved following quality, others were firm. FF varieties met with improved demand. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOP grades met with improved interest. Premium flowery teas showed significant improvement.

Turkey, Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.

Western Teas

Select best Western High Grown BOPs were firm to irregularly dearer, the below best and plainer varieties gained Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- and more. Select best Western High Grown BOPFs were firm to Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- dearer, the below best and plainer varieties gained by a similar margin. Medium BOPs were dearer by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, the BOPFs too appreciated by Rs.50/-.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

There were hardly any BOPs on offer, the BOPFs gained from last levels.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs were dearer by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, the BOPFs too followed a similar trend. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were dearer by Rs.100/- to Rs.150/- at times, the BOPFs were dearer by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/-.

CTC Teas

Low Grown CTC BP1s appreciated irregularly, the High and Medium sorts were firm to irregular. Low Grown PF1s were firm on last levels, the High and Medium sorts were irregularly dearer.

MARKET DESCRIPTION



Low Grown

Select best OP1s gained sharply, best and below best sorts too met with fair demand, secondaries were irregular. Well-made OPs were mainly firm, however with improved demand following quality. Select best OPAs were firm to dearer, best and below best types met with irregular demand with the prices fetching around last week's closing levels, secondaries tended lower. All BOP1s gained from last levels. Well-made Pekoes along with the heavy bold Pekoes were lower by Rs.30/- to Rs.50/- and more at times, flaky secondaries too declined irregularly. Shotty Pekoe1s tended lower, others too met with lower demand.

Select best and best BOPs were dearer by Rs.30/- to Rs.50/-, below best and secondary types too were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with improved demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best and best FBOPF1s were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/- and more following quality , below best types were firm, secondary types were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-. Select best and best FBOPs were dearer by Rs.40/-, below best types were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, secondary types were firm. FBOPF varieties met with very good demand. All Premium Flowery teas were substantially dearer.

Off Grades

Select best and best Fgs1s were dearer by Rs.50/- to Rs.60/-, below best and poorer sorts were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/- and more towards the closure. Select best and best BMs were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-, whilst below best and poorer types declined by Rs.30/- to Rs.40/- and more at times. Select best and best BPs were dearer by Rs.30/- to Rs.50/-, whilst below best and poorer varieties maintained on last levels. Select best BOP1As were higher by Rs.30/- to Rs.60/-, best types were higher by Rs.60/- to Rs.20/-, below best types were higher by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/-, whilst poorer sorts were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-.

Dust

Select best and best Dust1s were irregularly lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.50/-, below best and poorer types were firm. High and Medium CTCs showed an irregular demand. Low Grown CTCs declined by Rs.40/- to Rs.60/-. Low Grown Dust / Dust1s declined by Rs.40/- to Rs.80/- and more towards the closure.

Crop intakes are low.

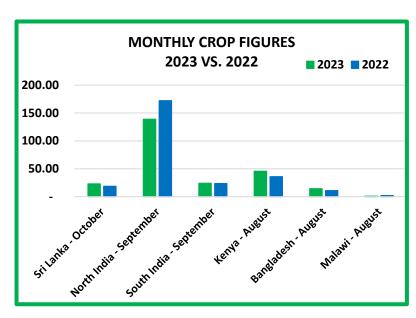


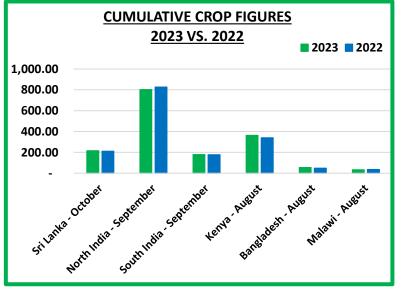
