

The 0.8Mkg of Ex E state teas on offer met with fair demand at slightly easier levels. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs were firm, the below best and plainer varieties were tending easier, whist the plainer types were barely steady. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs too were firm to marginally easier at times, the below best and plainer varieties were tending lower. Nuwara Eliya BOPs were irregularly lower, there were hardly any BOPFs on offer this week. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were easier, the BOPFs declined following quality. UVA BOPs declined substantially, the BOPFs followed a similar trend. Low grown CTC BP1s were firm, the High and Medium sorts were irregularly lower. Low Grown CTC PF1s were firm on last levels, the High Grown sorts were barely steady whilst the Medium Grown types mostly declined.


The 2.3Mkg of Low Grown teas which were on offer met with lower demand. In the Leafy segment, OP/OPA were firm. Select best and best OP1s were lower, others too met with lower demand. In the Semi Leafy segment, BOP1s were lower to last. Pekoe varieties were firm, Pekoe1s were irregularly lower. In the Small Leaf segment, FBOPs were lower to last. FBOPF varieties continued with lower demand. FBOPF1s too were lower to last. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOPF, BOPS too met with lower demand. All Premium Flowery teas were lower.

Turkey, Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.

### **Western Teas**

Select best BOPs were firm to Rs.50/- easier at times, the below best and plainer varieties too were firm by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- easier. Select best BOPFs were firm to a little easier at times, the below best and plainer sorts were easier by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-. Medium BOPs declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, the BOPFs were firm to a little easier following quality.

#### Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOPs were irregular, there were hardly any BOPFs on offer.

#### **Uva Teas**

Uva BOP declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, the BOPFs were easier by Rs.100/-. Uda Pussellawa BOPs declined by Rs.100/- to Rs.150/-, the BOPFs declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- following quality.

#### **CTC** Teas

Low Grown BP1s were firm, the High and Medium sorts were irregularly lower. Low Grown PF1s were firm, the High Grown sorts were Rs.100/- to Rs.150/- easier, the Medium Grown sorts declined irregularly following quality.

# **MARKET DESCRIPTION**

### **Low Grown**

Select best OP1s were firm to marginally easier, best and below best types declined sharply and sold with lower demand, poorer sorts were firm. Well-made BOP1s were firm to marginally easier, others were firm on last levels. Select best OPs were mainly firm, best and below best types declined irregularly. Well-made OPAs gained by Rs.50/-, others maintained last levels. Select best Pekoes along with bold Pekoes were mainly steady, below best sorts were irregular. Shotty Pekoe1s eased by Rs.50/- and more at times, others met with reasonable demand.

Select best and best BOPs were lower by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, below best and secondary types were firm. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with reasonable demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best FBOPF1s were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.50/-, best and below best FBOPF1s too were lower by Rs.30/- to Rs.40/- and more following quality, secondaries were firm. Well-made FBOPs in the select best category were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.50/-, best and below best types too were lower by Rs.40/- to Rs.50/-, secondaries were firm. FBOPF varieties met with lower demand. All Premium Flowery teas were substantially lower.

#### **Off Grades**

Select best and best FGS1s were easier by Rs.20/- to Rs.40/-, below best and poorer types were easier by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Select best and best BMs were easier by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, below best and poorer types were firm. All BPs showed an irregular demand. Select best BOP1As were lower by Rs.150/- to Rs.200/-, best types met with good demand, below best types maintained on last levels whilst poorer sorts were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-/

### Dust

Select best and best Dust1s were firm to dearer by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, below best and poorer sorts appreciated by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. High and Medium CTCs appreciated by Rs.10/- to Rs.15/-. Low Grown CTCs met with fair demand and sold at last levels. Low Grown Dust/Dust1s appreciated by Rs.10/- to Rs.15/-.

Heavy rainfall was recorded throughout the day in Rathnapura, Deniyaya and Galle districts.







### **MOMBASA MARKET**

#### SALE NO. 43 – SALE OF 24<sup>TH</sup>, 25<sup>TH</sup> & 26<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2022

Improved general demand for the 194,376 packages (13,058,411.00 kilos) on offer at irregular levels following quality. 29.67% were neglected.

#### **OFFERINGS**

Leaf Grades	-	110,400 packages (7,275,525.00 kilos) – 32.93% unsold.
Dust Grades	-	64,920 packages (4,829046.00 kilos) – 29.39% unsold.
Secondary Grades -	19,056	packages (953,840.00 kilos) – 11.75% unsold.

#### MARKETS

Pakistan Packers, Egyptian Packers and Afghanistan lent more support with Bazaar, Sudan, Kazakhstan, other CIS states and Russia showing improved activity. Yemen, other Middle Eastern countries and UK maintained interest with more enquiry from Iran. Local Packers were more active. Somalia were active at the lower end of the market.

#### LEAF GRADES (M2)

**BP1:** 

Best – Saw irregular activity and varied between firm to USC46 above last levels to easier by up to USC44.

Brighter – Advanced by up to USC24 but a few invoices lost up to USC16.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were irregular ranging between steady to USC12 dearer to easier by up to USC12; plantation mediums varied between USC28 dearer to easier by USC18 with select invoices losing up to USC42.

Lower Mediums – Met more competition and appreciated by up to USC40 but a few lines eased by up to USC24.

Plainer – Appreciated by up to USC22 with selected improved teas dearer by up to USC36.

#### <u> PF1:</u>

**Best** – Were firm to USC17 above previous levels.

Brighter – Steady to USC15 dearer.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were firm to USC12 dearer however a few lines shed up to USC9 while plantation mediums advanced by up to USC11.

Lower Mediums - Were mostly dearer by up to USC20 but some teas lost up to USC14.

Plainer – Met improved competition and were steady to USC14 above previous prices with only a few lines easier by up to USC10.

#### DUST GRADES (M1)

PDUST:

Best – Met irregular interest and varied between firm to USC10 dearer to easier by a similar margin.

Brighter – Steady to USC10 easier and select invoices lost up to USC16.

Mediums – KTDA mediums varied between firm to USC4 dearer to easier by up to USC3 while plantation mediums were steady to USC10 above previous levels.

Lower Medium – Saw good competition and appreciated by up to USC18.

Plainer – Were irregular ranging between firm to USC15 dearer to easier by up to USC14.



### **MOMBASA MARKET – Continued ;**

#### DUST1:

Best – Varied between firm to USC16 dearer to easier by up to USC14.

Brighter – Irregular with some invoices steady to USC20 above last rates while others shed up to USC14.

**Mediums** – KTDA mediums were firm to USC9 dearer with a few lines advancing by up to USC20 while other select invoices lost up to USC20. Plantation mediums appreciated by up to USC10 but a few teas shed up to USC13.

Lower Medium – Were firm to USC18 above previous prices.

Plainer – Ranged between steady to USC10 dearer to easier by a similar margin.

#### **SECONDARY GRADES (S1)**

In the Secondary Catalogues, **BPs** advanced with **PFs** steady. Clean well sorted coloury **Fannings** were firm to dearer while **similar DUSTs** appreciated. **Other Fannings** held value with **DUSTs** dearer. **BMFs** were readily absorbed at firm rates.

**CTC LEAF**: 54,742 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a fairly good demand.

**BROKENS**: A handful of well made Invoices met with quite a good demand and were about firm. Medium and other types witnessed less demand and prices were easier following quality with fair withdrawals. Plain types saw a further erosion in demand and generally declined by upto Tk.5/- to Tk.7/- with more withdrawals. BLF teas met with fair interest and were about steady to slightly easier but there were heavier withdrawals.

**FANNINGS**: A handful of good liquoring Fannings were well sought after by the buyers and were about steady to slightly easier often declining by Tk.3/- to Tk.5/-. Other types saw a little less demand and were easier by Tk.4/- to Tk.6/- with fair withdrawals. Plain varieties witnessed less demand and declined in price following quality with heavier withdrawals. BLF teas met with fair interest and were about steady to slightly easier but there were heavier withdrawals.

**CTC DUST**: 12,086 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a fairly good demand. Good liquoring well made Dusts met with a better demand and sold at firm levels whilst Medium descriptions were irregularly easier. Plain and BLF Dusts were less in demand and witnessed more withdrawals compared to last. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

**COMMENTS:** Buyers were more discriminating this week whereby a few bright teas elicited strong support whilst all others declined in price following quality. Blenders once again were the mainstay of the market with some support from the Loose tea buyers.

Good liquoring Dusts were a strong feature of the sale.
