The 0.6Mkg of Ex estate teas on offer met with fair demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs were firm to a little dearer following quality, the below best and plainer varieties were irregular. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs were selectively dearer, the below best and plainer varieties were firm to irregular. Nuwara Eliya BOPs were irregular, the BOPFs were firm. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were irregular following quality, the BOPFs were marginally dearer. UVA BOPs were easier, the BOPFs gained following quality. Low grown CTC BP1s were firm, the High and Medium sorts were tending easier. Low Grown CTC PF1s were irregularly dearer, the High and medium sorts were mostly firm.

The 1.9Mkg of Low Grown teas which were on offer met with good demand. In the Leafy segment, OPs were firm, OPAs appreciated a few rupees. Select best OP1s were firm, others were dearer. In the Semi Leafy segment, BOP1s were firm, Pekoe varieties followed a similar trend. Pekoe1s met with irregular demand. In the Small Leaf segment, FBOPs were firm. FBOPF varieties continued to attract good demand. FBOPF1s were firm. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOP.SP and BOPs too met with fair demand. Best Premium Flowery teas were firm, others met with irregular demand.

Turkey, Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.

Medium BOPs were firm to a little dearer at times, the BOPFs were firm on last levels.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOPs were irregular following quality, the BOPFs were firm to a little dearer at times.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs were tending a little easier, the BOPFs were firm to Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- dearer following quality. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were irregular following quality, the BOPFs were marginally dearer by Rs.50/- at times.

Low Grown

Select best OP1s met with irregular demand, other wiry OP1s along with the bolder types were firm to dearer. Better twisted OPs maintained last levels, others too gained irregularly. Well-made OPAs were firm to dearer by Rs.50/-, below best sorts too met with fair demand. In the Semi Leafy segment, better twisted BOP1s were firm, others too maintained last levels. Select best Pekoes along with the heavy bold Pekoe invoices were mostly firm. Shotty Pekoe1s met with good demand, reducers were firm to marginally lower.

Select best and best BOPs were firm, below best types were irregularly lower to last, secondary types were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. BOP.SPs and BOPF.SPs met with fair demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best FBOPF1's were firm on last week's closing levels, best and below best FBOPF1s were firm, secondaries were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. Well-made FBOPs in the select best category were firm, best and below best types too were firm, secondaries were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. FBOPF varieties met with good demand. Select best very tippy Premium Flowery teas met with good demand, others were irregularly lower to last.

Off Grades

All types of Fngs1s were firm. Select best and best BMs were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.30/-, below best and poorer types were firm. Select best and best BPs were firm, below best and poorer types were dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-. Select best BOP1As were dearer by Rs.60/- to Rs.80/- whilst best types were lower by Rs.50/- to Rs.60/- and more at times, below best and poorer sorts were dearer by Rs.40/- to Rs.50/-.

Crop intakes are moderate to low.






MOMBASA MARKET

Reduced demand in most categories on offer with prices irregular following quality for the 221,580 packages (14,896,114.00 kilos) available; 29.90% were neglected.

MARKETS

Pakistan Packers, Bazaar, and Afghanistan lent strong support with Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries maintaining good enquiry. Kazakhstan, other CIS states and UK were more selective while Sudan, Egyptian Packers and Iran reduced activity. Russia were less active while Local Packers maintained interest. Somalia maintained activity at the lower end of the market.

LEAF GRADES (M2)

BP1:

Best – Saw irregular enquiry and ranged between firm to USC9 dearer for most lines with a few selected invoices gaining between USC29 and USC56 to easier by USC18.

Brighter – Were irregular varying between firm to USC13 dearer and select lines advanced by up to USC35 to USC17 below last rates.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were fully firm for most teas but some lines were irregular ranging between USC20 dearer to USC16 below previous levels. Plantation mediums were steady to USC14 dearer.

Lower Mediums – Varied between firm to USC12 dearer to USC14 below previous prices.

Plainer – Were discounted by up to USC30 but a few selected invoices advanced by up to USC26.

PF1:

Best – Were mostly steady to USC10 dearer but a few teas eased by a similar margin.

Brighter – Irregular ranging between firm to USC8 dearer to easier by USC4.

Mediums – KTDA mediums varied between steady to USC10 dearer to USC8 below last rates while plantation mediums met reduced competition and lost up to USC20.

Lower Mediums – Were discounted by up to USC24.

Plainer – Saw less enquiry and most teas lost up to USC17 with only a few lines dearer by up to USC8.

DUST GRADES (M1)

Best – Met irregular activity and varied between steady to USC19 dearer to USC20 below previous levels.

Brighter – Were firm to easier by up to USC18.

Mediums - KTDA mediums were mostly steady at last prices but a few select invoices lost up to USC26 with plantation mediums firm to USC11 easier.

Lower Medium – Were a weak feature and shed by up to USC30.

Plainer – Were discounted by up to USC20.





MOMBASA MARKET – Continued;

DUST1:

Best – Irregular ranging between firm to USC23 dearer to easier by USC12.

Brighter – Were steady to USC6 below last rates.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were firm to USC10 easier for most of the teas with only a few lines advancing by up to USC13. Plantation mediums were irregularly easier by up to USC19 but selected invoices gained up to USC20.

Lower Medium - Lost up to USC20.

Plainer – Firm to USC13 easier.

SECONDARY GRADES (S1)

In the Secondary Catalogues, best **BPs** gained while others tended easier; best **PFs** appreciated with others firm. Clean well sorted coloury **Fannings** held value with **similar DUSTs** firm. **Other Fannings** were barely steady while **DUSTs** sold at previous rates. **BMFs** were readily absorbed.

CHITTAGONG MARKET

SALE NO.30 – 28TH NOVEMBER 2022

CTC LEAF: 58,775 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a stronger demand.

BROKENS: The best varieties were well supported and were fully firm whilst good types met with a stronger demand and advanced in price following competition. There was also quite a fair demand for the Medium varieties which were generally steady. Plain teas saw a little more demand at around last levels. There was better disposal of BLF varieties at last levels with less withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Best Fannings continued to attract strong demand at around firm rates. Good varieties saw stronger demand with prices appreciating further. Medium types were well absorbed at steady levels. Plain varieties saw a little more demand and were about steady with fewer withdrawals. BLF teas had a better sale at steady rates.

CTC DUST: 12,824 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with good demand. Good liquoring Dusts fetched firm to occasionally dearer prices. Mediums sold well at around last levels. Plain and BLF Dusts were once again an easier market and saw fair withdrawals. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: Blenders operated very strongly across the board especially on bright liquoring varieties. Loose tea buyers were not as active as in the last week.

Dusts sold well.
