

The Auction averages for the month of November 2022 recorded at Rs.1,383.05, is an increase of Rs.737.10 in comparison to November 2021, which was at Rs.645.95. When analyzing the respective elevations, the High Growns recorded an average of Rs.1,340.75 which is a positive variance of Rs.728.92 in comparison to Rs.611.83 in November 2021. Medium Growns too recorded a positive variance of Rs.597.71 with an average of Rs.1,177.49 when compared to Rs.579.78 in November 2021. Similarly, a positive variance of Rs.774.04 was also recorded in the Low Growns with an average of Rs.1,448.15 in comparison to Rs.674.11 in November 2021.

The 0.60Mkg of Ex estate teas on offer met with good demand. Select Best Western High Grown BOPs were firm following quality, the below best and plainer varieties were firm to a little irregular at times. Select Best Western High Grown BOPFs were firm on last levels, the below best and plainer varieties were tending irregular. Nuwara Eliya BOPs were barely steady, the BOPFs were irregular following quality. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were irregularly easier, the BOPFs too declined substantially at times. UVA BOPs were easier, the BOPFs followed a similar trend. The Low grown CTC BP1s were barely steady, the High and Medium sorts were tending irregular. Low Grown CTC PF1s were firm to a little irregular at times, the High and medium sorts too followed a similar trend.

The 2.4Mkg of Low Grown teas which were on offer met with good demand. In the Leafy segment, OPs were firm, OPAs appreciated a few rupees. Select best OP1s were firm, others were dearer. In the Semi Leafy segment, Select best BOP1s were dearer, other BOP1s were firm, Pekoe varieties were firm on last levels. Pekoe1s gained on quality. In the Small Leaf segment, FBOPs were firm. FBOPF varieties continued to attract good demand. Select best FBOPF1s were firm others were irregular. BOPF.SP, BOPF, BOPS, and BOPs too met with fair demand. Best Premium Flowery teas were firm, others met with irregular demand.

Turkey, Russia, Iran and the C.I.S countries lent fair support. Libya and Iraq were active.

Western Teas

Select best BOPs were firm on last levels, below best and plainer varieties were tending irregular. Select best BOPFs too were firm, the below best and plainer varieties were firm to Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- easier at times. Medium BOPs were firm, BOPFs too followed a similar trend.

Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOPs were irregular, the BOPFs too were irregular following quality.

Uva Teas

Uva BOPs were easier by Rs.50/-, the BOPFs too followed a similar trend. Uda Pussellawa BOPs were irregularly easier by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/-, the BOPFs too declined by Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- and more following quality.

CTC Teas

Low Grown BP1s were barely steady, the High and Medium types too were irregular. Low Grown PF1s were irregular following quality, the High and Medium types were firm to irregularly lower at times.

MARKET DESCRIPTION

Low Grown

Select best OP1s were firm on last levels, best types were irregular, below best types along with the secondaries met with good demand. Well-made OPs were fully firm and occasionally dearer, secondaries too were mostly firm. select best and best OPAs maintained last levels, secondaries were firm to irregularly dearer by Rs.30/- to Rs.50/-. In the Semi Leafy segment, well-made BOP1s met with good demand, bolder types sold at last levels. Shotty Pekoes along with heavy bold Pekoe invoices were mostly firm, secondaries met with fair demand. Shotty Pekoe1s were irregular, below best types however were firm on last levels.

Select best and best BOPs were firm , below best types were irregularly lower to last, secondary types were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. Select best BOP.SPs were easier by Rs.40/- to Rs.50/-, others were firm. BOPF.SPs met with fair demand. BOPFs followed a similar trend. Select best FBOPF1s were firm on last week's closing levels, best and below best FBOPF1s were firm to easier by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-, secondaries were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. Well-made FBOPs in the select best category were firm, best and below best types too were firm, secondaries were dearer by Rs.20/- to Rs.30/-. FBOPF varieties met with good demand. Select best very tippy Premium Flowery teas met with good demand, others were irregularly lower to last.

Off Grades

Select best and best FGS1s declined by Rs.10/- to Rs.20/-, below best and poorer types were firm. Select best BMs showed an irregular demand, below best and poorer types were firm. All BPs were firm. Select best and best BOP1AS were lower by Rs.50/- to Rs.80/- and more at times, below best and poorer sorts maintained on last levels.

Dust

Select best and best Dust1s appreciated Rs.10/- to Rs.15/- and more at times as the sale progressed, below best types were firm to dearer by Rs.10/- to Rs.15/-, poorer sorts appreciated Rs.10/- to Rs.15/-. High and Medium CTCs deprecated Rs.10/- to Rs.15/-. Low Grown CTCs met with fair demand and sold at last levels. Low Grown Dust/ Dust1s were lower by Rs.10/- to Rs.15/-.

Crop intakes are moderate to low.






CTC LEAF: 58,929 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a fairly good demand at easier rates.

BROKENS: A few best Brokens on offer were well supported but were slightly easier following quality. Good and Medium varieties saw fair demand but prices eased. There was also some withdrawals. Plain types met with only a little demand and prices declined by about Tk.5/- to Tk.7/- with several withdrawals. BLF teas followed a similar trend as of last week with a little less withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Best Fannings once again attracted good demand but prices were easier upto Tk.5/- and more. Good types followed a similar trend whilst Mediums saw fair interest and were about steady. However, there were some withdrawals. Plain types saw only some interest from buyers and rates declined with more withdrawals. BLF teas followed a similar trend as of last week with a little less withdrawals.

CTC DUST: 13,111 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with fair demand. Good liquoring teas sold well at easier prices. Mediums sold fairly well and were fully firm on last. Plain and BLF Dusts were an easier market and saw fair withdrawals. Blenders were very active whilst Loose tea buyers were selective.

COMMENTS: Blenders operated in usual strength although at slightly lower levels. Loose tea buyers were much less active and operated selectively. As a result of which there was less competition with lowering of rates. There was more withdrawals this week.

Dusts met with fair demand with some withdrawals.
